Dear Licensee:

WXTU License Limited Partnership ('WXTU') is hereby notified of the modification of its license (BMLH-20140821ABX) for WSOC-FM, Charlotte, North Carolina to specify operation on Channel 279C0 in lieu of Channel 279C.<sup>2</sup>

On May 18, 2015, Alpha Media Licensee LLC, licensee of FM Station WHXT(FM), filed an amendment to its minor change construction permit application. The WHXT amended application proposed that WSOC's license and assignment be modified to specify Class C0 in lieu of Class C in accordance with the procedures set forth in Note 4 of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3573.<sup>3</sup> Accordingly, by staff letter dated July 15, 2015, WSOC was directed to show cause

why its license should not be modified to specify Channel 279C0 in lieu of Channel 279C. On July 31, 2015 WXTU filed a response to the order to show cause letter consenting to the downgrade from Channel 279C to Channel 279C0. In the letter, WXTU requested that Station WSOC-FM no longer be designated a Section 73.215 contour protection station (47 C.F.R. Section 73.215).<sup>4</sup>

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority found in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303, and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b), 0.283, 1.420, 73.203(b), and 73.3573 of the Commission's Rules, as amended, IT IS ORDERED, that effective the date of this letter, the FM assignment, IS MODIFIED, as follows:

Charlotte, NC	Add 279C0
	Delete 279C

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to Section 316(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, licenses BMLH-20140821ABX, BLH-19980528KB and BXLH-20090514ABP ARE MODIFIED to specify operation on Channel 279C0 in lieu of Channel 279C. Furthermore, pursuant to WXTU's request, Station WSOC-FM will no longer be designated a Section 73.215 contour protection station.
