TECHNICAL STATEMENT

1. This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Legend Communications of Wyoming, LLC ("Legend"), licensee of KLGW, Channel 24.3C1, Buffalo, Wyoming and KZZS, Channel 25.2C1, Story, Wyoming. Legend is submitting an application to correct the coordinates and elevation of KLGW and KZZS, as such a Radio Market analysis is needed. Legend is also the licensee of KBBS, 1450 kHz, Buffalo, Wyoming.¹ None of these facilities is licensed to, or considered "home", in any rated market. Therefore, a study demonstrating compliance with the Commission's multiple ownership rules in a non-rated market is required.

2. The 3.16 mV/m contours of the proposed KLGW and KZZS overlap with the contour of KBBS. A map depicting the city grade contours of these facilities is shown on Exhibit #1. Therefore, a study has been conducted to determine if ownership of these facilities complies with §73.3555 of the Commission's rules. The contours of KLGW and KBBS will be used to define

1) Legend is also the licensee of KZMQ, 1140 kHz, (KZMQ also has an outstanding construction permit to relocate and change city of license from Greybull, Wyoming to Ten Sleep, Wyoming, which is considered herein) and KZMQ-FM, Channel 26.2C, Greybull, Wyoming; KWOR, 1340 kHz, Worland, Wyoming; KCGL, Channel 28.1C, Powell, Wyoming; KODI, 1400 kHz, and KTAG, Channel 25.0C, Cody, Wyoming; and KBBS, 1450 kHz, as depicted on Exhibit #1. As indicated, there is no overlap between the proposed KLGW or KZZS with any of these other Legend stations and these stations are not considered further.

Legend is also the licensee of KGWY, Channel 26.4C1, Gillette, Wyoming; KAML-FM, Channel 24.5C0, and KIML, 1270 kHz, Gillette, Wyoming; and KDDV-FM, Channel 26.8C0 Wright, Wyoming. These stations are so far removed that they are not shown on Exhibit #1 and these stations are not considered further.

the market boundary, hereinafter referred to as the "Radio Market".² The study will determine the number of other commercial AM and FM stations that either have transmitter sites within, or provide coverage to, the Radio Market. Only those stations with transmitter sites within 92.0 kilometers will be considered as contributors to the market. No other station in which Legend has an interest will be considered, unless it is a subject station in the market under review.

3. Exhibit #2 is a depiction of the stations within, or providing service to, the Radio Market boundary. Exhibit #3 is a tabulation of the stations in the Radio Market, which totals seven when the three subject stations are included.³ The number of stations depicted falls in the fourteen or fewer stations tier of §73.3555(a)(1)(iv) of the Commission's rules. At the fourteen and fewer stations level, common ownership or control of up to five stations, with no more than three in the same service, is permissible, provided the number of stations to be commonly held does not exceed 50% of the stations in the market. Therefore, Legend is in compliance with the Commission's multiple ownership rules for a non-rated market.

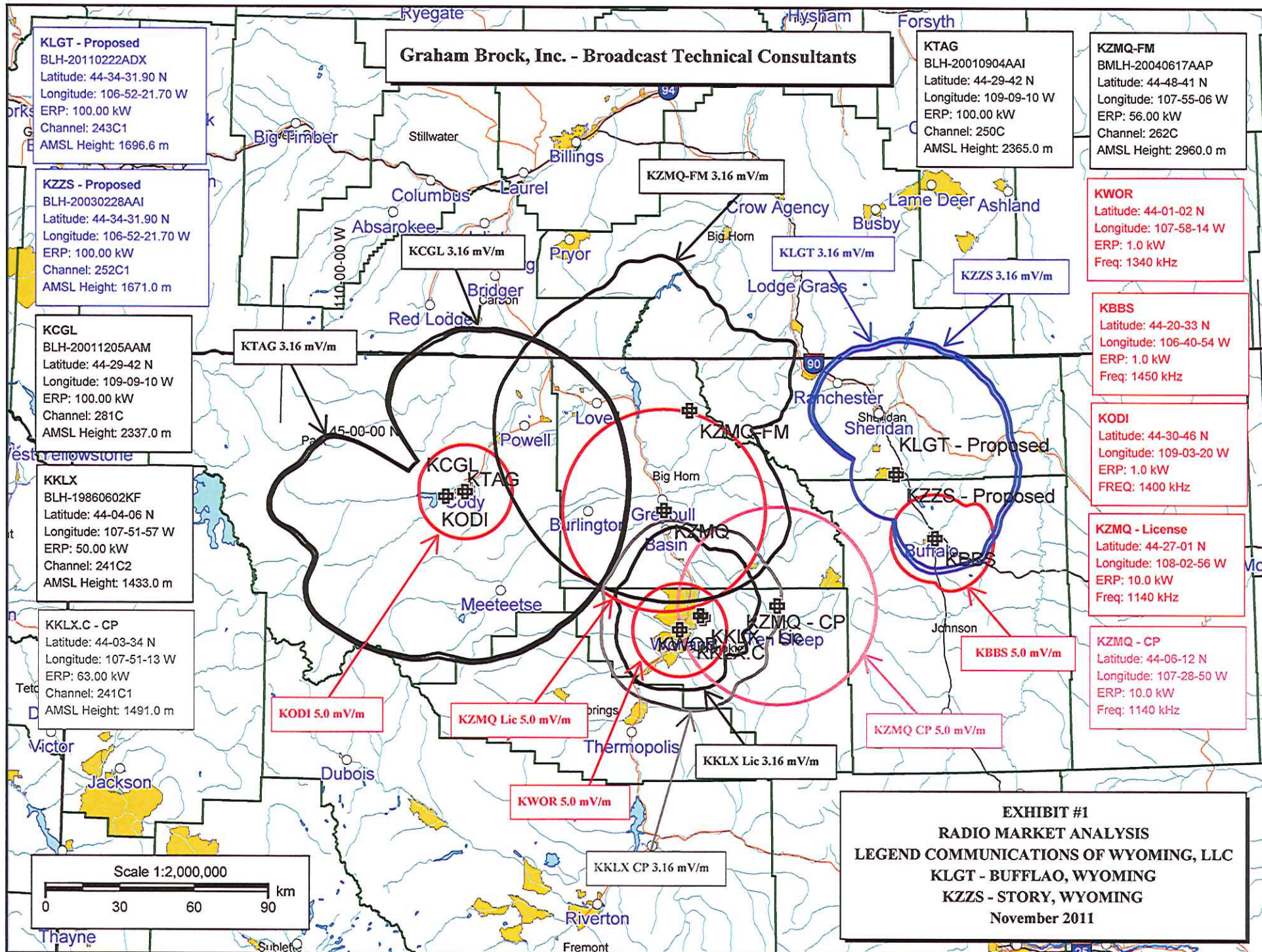
4. Based on compliance shown in the non-rated market reviewed, the applications for KLGT and KZZS, in conjunction with Legend's interest in KBBS, are in compliance with the Commission's multiple ownership rules, as detailed in §73.3555.

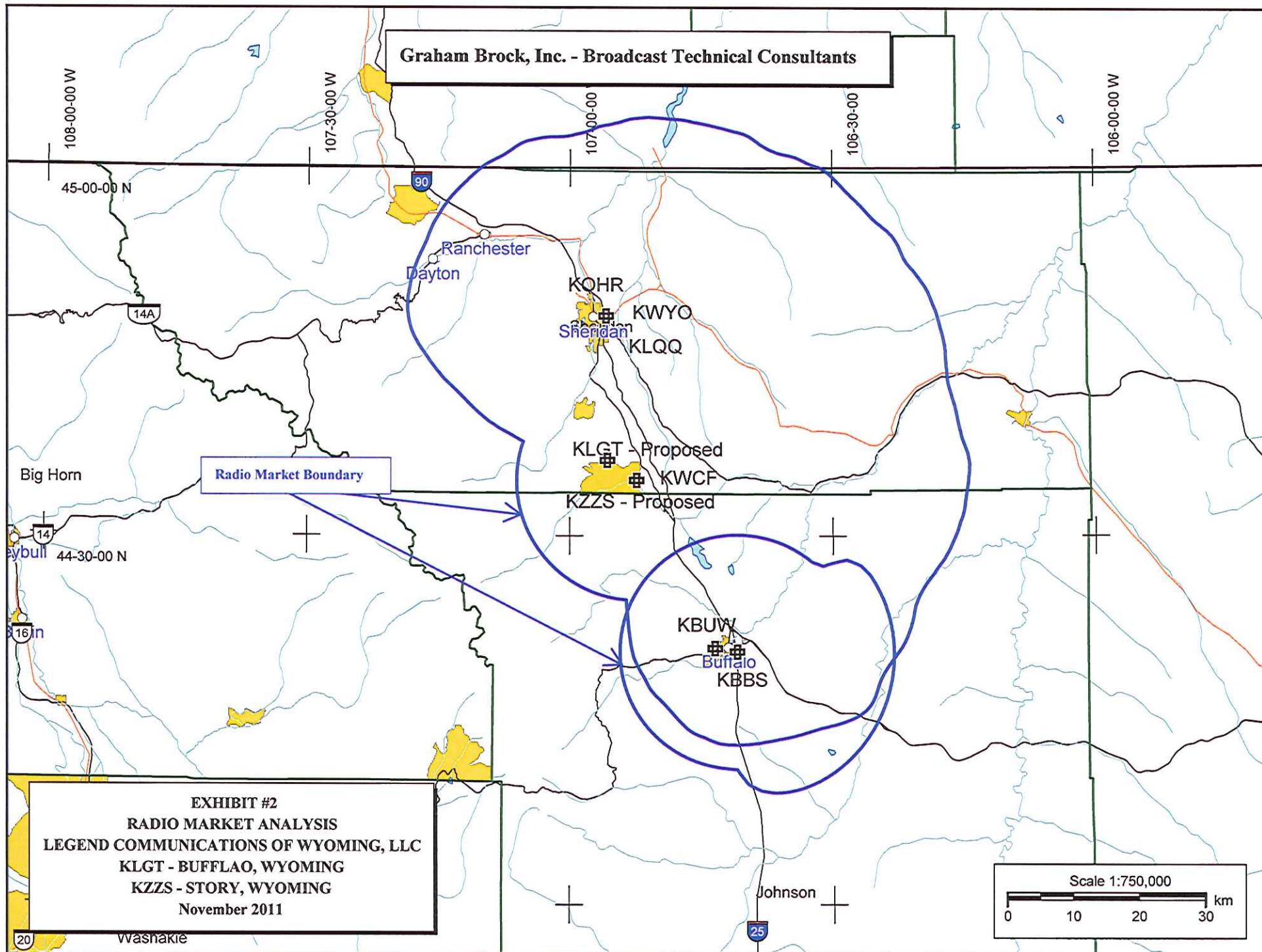


