30-Day Progress Report

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is in response to the letter dated May 13, 2014 regarding our above-referenced pending application for a new LPFM station at Monticello, Mississippi. The FCC's letter inquires about our efforts to comply with the Environmental Policy Act, and we are required to submit a Progress Report every 30 days. This supplements our prior letter that was submitted by counsel to the FCC staff on May 27, 2014. This Progress Report is being submitted one week early due to my counsel's out-of-town travel obligations for next week.

On June 19, 2014 a representative from Dynamic Environmental Associates made a site visit to the proposed transmitter site. I have been advised of the following:

1. The informal biological assessment is currently underway.
2. The migratory bird results show that the site adheres to the fishery and wildlife recommendations for communications towers.
3. The file review for the Mississippi state SHPO has been completed and there are no archeological sites or historic structures within the potential effects area.
4. The Form 621 should be submitted to the Mississippi State Historic Office within the next few days.

5. Five Indian Tribes fell within the TCNS notification. Two of these tribes have already provided clearance.

We expect to demonstrate further progress in our next 30-day report.
