Explanation of Circumstances Warranting Grant of STA

WWAZ License, LLC (“WWAZ License”), holds a permit that authorizes WWAZ License to operate new primary digital UHF commercial television broadcasting station WWAZ-DT on Channel 44 in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin (File No. BPCDT-19991101ADW, granted on June 2, 2000, as modified by File No. BMPCDT-20000908ABG, granted on February 22, 2001, and BMPCDT-20040209ABG, granted on June 22, 2004, and as extended by File Nos. BEPCDT-20020301AFZ, granted on June 7, 2002, BEPCDT-20021008AAQ, granted on January 31, 2003, BEPCDT-20060724ACU, granted on May 17, 2007, and BEPCDT-20071116ADH, granted on December 31, 2007). Station WWAZ-DT bears the Commission’s Facility Identification Number 60571.

As we notified the Commission in our letter to the Commission’s Secretary that was dated and filed with the Commission on behalf of WWAZ License on January 17, 2008, the Station temporarily suspended broadcast operations on January 9, 2008, due to financial constraints. WWAZ License is actively working to develop a strategic plan for the optimal use of the Station’s resources in order to resolve this situation, and so that the Station may resume its broadcast service at the earliest practicable date.

Accordingly, as required by Section 73.1740(a)(4) of the Commission’s Rules and Regulations, WWAZ License respectfully requests a special temporary authorization (“STA”) from the Commission to permit Station WWAZ-DT to remain “dark” for more than 30 consecutive days. It is hoped and believed that an STA of six (6) months duration will prove sufficient to resolve the Station’s current operational/financial challenges. The public interest will be served by a grant of the STA, because this STA will allow Station WWAZ-DT to continue serving its viewers, once its challenging financial situation is resolved.
