Bellevue, Idaho Fill-in DTS Translator
State Board of Education, State of Idaho

In response to the request for explanation of the "extraordinary circumstances" which warrant this operation, which is allowed by the Commission's DTS Fill-In Rules, State Board of Education, State of Idaho (Applicant) states that there is a "loss area" outside of the KIPT-DT authorized signal contour area where there is marginal to below threshold of visibility (TOV) digital signal level. The Bellevue, Idaho community will have little to no DTV services from KIPT-DT. Over the air (OTA) viewers who reside in this "loss area" would have to go to extreme measures to gain free reliable digital reception or may have no access to our digital signals at all, whereas they could receive our analog channel 13 signal previously.

Applicant requests a waiver of the rules which allow DTS fill-in within the DTV noise-limited contours because the proposed service will cover a community (Bellevue, Idaho.) that is well within the Table of Distances allowed for our KIPT-DT primary station. We desire to locate a DTS translator in the loss community as soon as possible to provide continued OTA service. All interference guidelines and rules will be adhered to as Applicant works to provide "fill-in" service for Bellevue, Idaho.
