Subject: Request for application dismissal, Facility ID: 191768

Greetings:

On November 14, 2013 the Federal Communications Commission closed the filing window for new Low Power FM Broadcast Stations (LPFM). Prior to this date, an application was submitted on behalf of Pahrump Film Festival Inc. (Facility ID: 191768). According to records obtained from the Nevada Secretary of State, this organization was formed March 17, 2006 by Geraldine Ahrens and Harvey Caplan. Per engineering data provided to the Commission by the Applicant, the proposed transmitter site is at 2370 Grieco Way, Pahrump, Nevada, 89060. This is the residence of Geraldine Ahrens.

During the same LPFM filing window, Talk Radio of Pahrump Inc. submitted a separate application (Facility ID: 191832). The same Geraldine Ahrens and Harvey Caplan are listed in records of the Nevada Secretary of State as being current officers of the corporation.

FCC regulations 47 CFR 73.855 state:

"Ownership limits. (a) No authorization for an LPFM station shall be granted to any party if the grant of that authorization will result in any such party holding an attributable interest in two or more LPFM stations."

Whereas Geraldine Ahrens and Harvey Caplan hold such an interest in Talk Radio of Pahrump Inc. and Pahrump Film Festival Inc., the granting of both LPFM licenses would be in violation of 47 CFR 73.855.

It is hereby requested that the application by Pahrump Film Festival Inc. (Facility ID: 191768) be dismissed without further action.
