INFORMAL OBJECTION

Re: BNPED-20071022BDQ/ BNED-20071022BDB CHESAPEAKE CATHOLIC RADIO.

1. The applicant(s) have filed for numerous Communities in this NCE window.
2. The objection(s) herein are illustrative of, not only the applicant's filings, but also of the "umbrella" organization...Eternal Word Television Network.
3. The EWTN applications in this window (listed as ONE), actually encompass more than (100) if consideration is given to the "related" applicants.
4. More to the point. With respect to the two applications above, (a) Applicant for both locations has failed to obtain "reasonable assurance" with regards the use of the proposed towers. (Proof of which has been obtained from the tower owner).
5. The first and second aural are less than other MX competitors. (Pennsville)
6. The applicant principals have been filed by an "outstanding" Federal Communications Attorney. He and his wife (employee) are the sole owners of the newly organized "Chesapeake Catholic Radio, Inc".
7. The application contains other misinformation which is not mentioned now.
8. Whether an FCC "outstanding" attorney is permitted to file on his own behalf is only a question for the Commission. Not the purpose of this objection.
9. In particular, the applicant for Port Penn neither has requested, nor could obtain, permission to locate on the tower it proposed. Such authority has already been granted to others...this also includes Smyrna DE (one of the other applications)
10. It is also noted that the "contact" person for Chesapeake as listed in the application(s) has been contacting at least one other MX applicant in an effort to force a withdrawal of that and possibly other MX applicants in these situations.
11. The applicant listed in the objections above must be eliminated from the competition by virtue of its' errors, its' misstatements, its' efforts at intimidation and its' possible "conflict of interest" involving attorney(s) connected with Commission filings as "agents" and now "principals" in this window.
