

**USE OF THE STATION FOR  
ADVANCEMENT OF AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM**


Covenant Network (Covenant) was formed as a Section 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation "exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, scientific and literary purposes". Covenant is an existing educational broadcaster (see Exhibit 4 for its current list of stations); it has been found qualified under 47 CFR §73.503 to operate stations in the non-commercial, educational portion of the FM band.

Covenant intends to use the proposed station for the advancement of an educational program similar to what is aired on Covenant's stations currently. In particular, Covenant intends to broadcast programs to teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church. In so doing, Covenant will substantially rely on the radio service of Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN). In this endeavor, the proposed station will be operated in a manner similar to that at its existing stations.

EWTN's programming is commercial-free, and there is no paid programming which is aired on EWTN. A current listing of EWTN radio programming follows this narrative.

Thus, the EWTN radio programming to be presented over the proposed station presents a comprehensive daily effort to educate the public, Catholics and non-Catholics, about the tenets and dogmas of the Roman Catholic faith, including the Bible and the systematic Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church.

Covenant Network intends to work with local Roman Catholic parishes, catechism programs and organizations to assist their educational efforts with respect to teaching of the Catholic religion; in sum, we will provide a valuable educational resource for the residents of the proposed station's listening area.
