**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Central Florida Educational Foundation, Inc. ("CFEF"), licensee of FM translator station W245AZ, Channel 245D, Leesburg, Florida. CFEF has a construction permit to make minor changes to the W245AZ facilities by increasing the height above ground, mean sea level and height above average terrain (BMPFT-20090220ACV). CFEF herein submits a license application to cover the outstanding permit. Attached as Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter power output for the W245AZ translator.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W245AZ permit. The first condition states that CFEF will reduce the power of W245AZ or cease operation to insure persons with access to the site are not exposed to radio frequency radiation levels above the limits. CFEF states that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of W245AZ or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines.

The second condition states that an application for license, FCC Form 350, must be on file prior to commencing program tests with the facilities authorized in the permit. The submission of this instant application satisfies the condition. Based on the foregoing, it is believed all conditions on the W245AZ construction permit have been satisfied.
