Dear Mr. Duvall:

This letter is provided in response to your request, and is prepared in accordance with Section 73.525 of the FCC's rules and the FCC's April 1, 2009 Public Notice (DA 09-744) regarding consents by TV Channel 6 stations to receive interference from noncommercial educational FM stations.

This is to advise you that WATE, Knoxville, Tennessee (Fac Id. 71082) has no objection to the filing and grant of an application for WEKF-FM, Corbin, Kentucky (Fac. Id. 92574) to modify its technical facilities and increase its coverage. WATE understands that the proposed technical parameters will result in facilities that cause interference to WATE's previously used television channel 6 facilities beyond what is otherwise allowed by Section 73.525 of the FCC's rules. Commensurate with any rights it may retain with respect to channel 6, WATE hereby unconditionally consents to such interference, and concurs with a grant of the application as filed or later amended.
