Dear Ms. Dortch:


Relevant Radio, Inc. (“RRI”), by its counsel, hereby informs the Commission that AM radio station KPJP, Greenville, California (Facility No. 92527) (“Station”) has been off the air since November 5, 2021. Due to the Dixie wildfires that ravaged many parts of California during the latter part of Summer 2021, the power lines that serve the Station’s transmitter site were badly damaged. The Station had been operating pursuant to a generator until November 5, 2021, but the Station no longer can remain on the air due to technical reasons. RRI has been informed by the landlord of the Station’s licensed transmitter site that repairs to the power lines are expected to be completed by the end of June 2022.

For the foregoing reasons, RRI respectfully requests silent authority associated with the Station until repairs to the power lines can be completed. RRI will inform the Commission when the Station is able to resume operating pursuant to the terms of its license.

RRI hereby certifies that neither it, nor any party thereto, is not subject to a denial of federal benefits that includes FCC benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the *Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988*, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
