I am writing this letter on behalf of Haitian Relief Radio & Community Services (Haitian Relief), one of the original three organizations under a timeshare agreement in MX Group 91 that included our organization, Awakening/Art & Culture (Awakening), File No. BNPL-20131106AJH, and Ministerio R.M. (Ministerio), File No. BNPL-20131113BOZ.


Prior to the close of the MX window, Haitian Relief amended its application to leave MX Group 91 and the timeshare agreement. The FCC subsequently awarded Awakening and Ministerio construction permits on March 23, 2015. Haitian Relief filed its petitions on April 27, 2015 seeking to move back into MX Group 91 and honor the terms of the timeshare agreement.

Should the FCC grant Haitian Relief's pending petition for reconsideration and petition for leave to amend its application, Awakening/Art & Culture would honor the originally proposed timeshare agreement between it, Haitian Relief, and Ministerio.

Haitian Relief is an important and vitally needed community-building asset for the Haitian community in Central Florida. Our organization, Awakening/Art & Culture shares similar intentions in serving the Latino community of Orlando, Florida.

I hope the issue can be resolved as soon as possible.
