Dear Sir or Madam:

On behalf of Townsquare License, LLC (“Townsquare”) (FRN 0030479497), licensee of the above-referenced station, pursuant to the Audio Division guidance issued on January 11, 2022, January 25, 2022 and May 2, 2022, we respectfully request special temporary authority for the station to operate at variance from its license as described more fully below.

The ground lease for the KMPT transmitter site is set to expire and thus the station needs to be relocated. Townsquare plans to diplex the station on the KGRZ site and has submitted an FCC Form 301 application to effectuate the move and modify the facilities accordingly (see BP-20220719AAC). In the meantime, in anticipation of the move, Townsquare needs to begin dismantling equipment at the current site. To accomplish this and keep the station on air, Townsquare proposes to operate the station non-directionally at 25 percent of licensed nighttime power. STA for such operations is respectfully requested.

Undersigned counsel has been authorized by Townsquare to state that neither Townsquare nor any party to this application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
