Contour Protection Agreement Carolina Christian Radio, INC. (WMYT-FM) Sea-Comm, INC. (WLTT-FM)

Carolina Christian Radio, INC., licensee of WMYT-FM, has filed an application with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to move their transmitting facility to a new tower location at 9016 Funston Road in Winnabow, NC. To allow the grant of the application, WLTT-FM licensed to Sea-Comm, INC. and located in Bolivia, NC would have to change its licensed status to allow Contour Protection per FCC rules 73.215. The Contour Protection afforded WLTT-FM from WMYT-FM, as proposed, would be to the "as built contours" that exist today and not the contours of a full Class "A" 6000 watt, 328' above average terrain station.

The grant of the WMYT-FM application is contingent on WLTT-FM filing an application to change its license to a rule 73.215 status. WLTT-FM has filed an application with the FCC requesting that change.

IT IS AGREED that Sea-Comm, INC. will accept contour protection to the as built contours for radio station WLTT-FM to allow the grant of the WMYT-FM application to relocate its transmitter facilities to the new location.

IT IS AGREED that Carolina Christian Radio, INC. will accept contour protection to the as built contours for WMYT-FM at the proposed location in the filed application.

IT IS AGREED that if the FCC does not grant one application then the other will be cancelled. With notification of the grant of both applications from the FCC, Sea-Comm,

INC. will immediately file for a license to cover with the FCC. WMYT-FM will not begin operations at the new location until a grant of the license to cover is made by the FCC for WLTT-FM.

This document, as filed with the FCC, is the complete terms of this agreement.


