Request for Waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 73.1125
(Main Studio Rule)

Dear Mr. Brewer:

The staff has under consideration the captioned application for assignment of license of station KZXV(FM), Seminole, Oklahoma, from American Family Association, Inc. to The Love Station, Inc. ("Love"). Love has requested a waiver of the Commission's Main Studio Rule, Section 73.1125, in order to operate station KZXV(FM) as a "satellite" of commonly owned noncommercial educational ("NCE") station KLVV(FM), Ponca City, Oklahoma.¹ For the reasons set forth below, we will waive Section 73.1125 and grant Love's application.

Main Studio Waiver. Pursuant to Section 73.1125(a), a broadcast station's main studio must be located either (1) within a station's community of license, (2) within the principal community contour of any other broadcast station licensed to its community, or (3) within 25 miles of the center of its community of license.² However, under Section
