WAIVER REQUEST - SECTION 73.37(A)
M-10 Broadcasting, Inc.

As outlined in Exhibit 14 to the attached application, the proposed upgraded WWLG daytime facilities will result in a very small amount of prohibited overlap between the proposed WWLG 0.5 mV/m daytime contour and the 0.025 mV/m daytime contour of WPAZ - Pottstown, Pennsylvania, which also operates on 1370 kHz. Figure 13.0 is a detailed map exhibit presenting an expanded view of this area of prohibited overlap. The contours in this detailed map exhibit were extracted from Tables 14.0.1 and 14.0.10 of Exhibit 14 to this application.

As shown in this map exhibit, the majority of this prohibited contour overlap will occur over Chesapeake Bay and, thus, is not cognizable. A very small portion of this overlap (0.83 square kilometers), however, will occur over land on the western shore of Chesapeake Bay. As shown in this map exhibit, however, the entire portion of this de minimis area of prohibited overlap which falls on land lies within the boundaries of the U. S. Army's Aberdeen Proving Ground and is located in an isolated, marshy portion of this proving ground which appears to be utilized solely for ordnance testing purposes. Thus, based on this map, there does not appear to be any population, either permanent or itinerant, located within this area of prohibited overlap. Thus, a waiver of Section 73.37(a) of the FCC Rules with regard to this de minimis area of prohibited overlap would serve the public interest due to the fact that any interference which might result from this overlap would occur totally over an unpopulated area.
