Request for tolling

Dear Ms. Meredith:

This is in reference to the July 17, 2019 tolling request and July 22, 2019 supplement (Tolling Request) you filed on behalf of Powell Meredith Communications Company (PMCC) for three construction permits for new FM Translator Stations: W270CS, Gulfport, Mississippi, File No. BNPFT-20150518AFL; K221GE, Wickenburg, Arizona, File No. BNPFT-20130827AEC; and K287BP, South Padre Island, Texas, File No. BNPFT-20130826AGH (collectively, Stations). Those three permits were granted on January 29, 2016 for three-year terms ending on January 29, 2019. The Tolling Request was filed pursuant to our November 15, 2018 Letter Order granting a six-month waiver of expiration for the Stations, which ended on July 29, 2019.<sup>1</sup> We hereby accept the Tolling Request and restore the Stations' construction terms.<sup>2</sup>

In the Tolling Request, PMCC submitted an order from the US Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah, dated December 16, 2016, that granted a proof of claim for "eight radio properties."<sup>3</sup> The Stations are referenced in the attached transcript,<sup>4</sup> and are thus included among the eight radio station properties in the bankruptcy estate as of that date, and encumbered (with respect to actions by creditors, including PMCC) by the stay in bankruptcy imposed by the Bankruptcy Court. We have determined that this Tolling Request complies with the Letter Order.

The Tolling Request also indicates that the Stations have been deemed abandoned by the Bankruptcy Trustee as of July 9, 2019,<sup>5</sup> and therefore are no longer encumbered by the stay in bankruptcy. We therefore will end tolling and add the remaining term of 1 year 9 months and 11 days remaining on the permits as of the original tolling request in June 2017. The expiration date of each Station's permit is April 20, 2021.
