TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Bilingual Broadcasting Foundation, Inc. ("BBF"), licensee of radio station KBBF, Channel 206B, Santa Rosa, California. BBF holds an outstanding permit to change the KBBF city of license at its existing site (BPED-20081009AIQ). BBF herein submits a license application to cover the outstanding permit. A calculation of the transmitter power output of the KBBF transmitter is attached as Exhibit A.

There are two operating conditions/restrictions on the KBBF permit. The first condition states that BBF will reduce the power of KBBF, or cease operation in coordination with other users of the tower, to protect persons having access to the site from radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines. BBF will comply with this condition.

The second condition states that the permit is for a change of community of license only, with no technical changes. BBF acknowledges this condition. Based on the foregoing, it is believed that KBBF is in compliance with the Commission's rules and that all conditions have been met.
