

DECLARATION

I, John R. Powley, hereby state as follows:

1. I have filed with the FCC a short-form application in File No. BNPTTL-20000831AQD for a construction permit for a new low power television station to operate on Channel 62 in Sioux City, Iowa (the "Powley 62 Application") and also have filed with the FCC a short-form application in File No. BNPTTL-20000831AQN for a construction permit for a new low power television station to operate on Channel 64 in Sioux City, Iowa (the "Powley 64 Application," and, together with the Powley 62 Application, collectively, the "Powley Applications").

2. Pappas Telecasting Companies ("PTC") has filed an application before the Federal Communications Commission (the "FCC") a short-form application for a construction permit for a low power television station to operate on Channel 63 in South Sioux City, Nebraska (File No. BNPTTL-20000831APO) (the "PTC Application").

3. Pursuant to an "Application Dismissal Agreement" by and between Powley and PTC (the "Settlement Agreement"), PTC has agreed to dismiss the PTC Application in exchange for the right to purchase from Powley a construction permit from the FCC authorizing the construction of a new low-power television station to operate on either Channel 62 or Channel 64 in Sioux City, Iowa for the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00). I hereby certify that this amount is not in excess of the fair market value estimated for the permit.

4. Other than the Settlement Agreement, there are no other agreements or understandings between PTC and Powley regarding the PTC Application or the Powley Applications. I certify that Powley has neither received nor been promised any consideration of any nature whatsoever, directly or indirectly, for the actions that it has agreed to take under the Settlement Agreement, except as set forth in the Settlement Agreement.

5. The Powley Applications were not filed for the purpose of entering into the Settlement Agreement or any similar agreement.

6. Approval of the Settlement Agreement will serve the public interest by expediting the issuance of authorizations by the FCC for two new low power television stations in Sioux City, Iowa.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
