Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed May 13, 2013, on behalf of Family Life Broadcasting System ("FLB"). FLB requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted November 14, 2012 to operate FM Translator W232CA with reduced power.¹ In support of the extension request, FLB states that it is in the process of pursuing county and local approvals for the facility authorized in construction permit BPFT-20120615ACO.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control, and that it has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.


¹ W232CA is licensed for operation on Channel 232D (94.3 MHz) with effective radiated power of 0.099 kilowatt (Max-DA, V only) and antenna height above average terrain of 278 meters. Construction Permit BPFT-20120615ACO authorizes a change to circular polarization and changes to the directional antenna pattern.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station W232CA may continue to operate with reduced power.

FLB must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. FLB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 11, 2013**.
