TECHNICAL STATEMENT

1. This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Cumulus Licensing LLC, permittee of a New FM station ("New FM") on Channel 244C3, Humboldt, Nebraska. Cumulus is proposing to change the community of license of the New FM station to Effingham, Kansas. As such, a Radio Market Analysis is needed. Effingham, Kansas, the proposed community of license, is not located in a metro county within any rated market. Principals of Cumulus have attributable interests in stations KMAJ, 1440 kHz, KTOP, 1490 kHz, and KDVV, Channel 262C Topeka, Kansas; KQTP, Channel 275C2, St. Marys, Kansas; and KCMO, 710 kHz, Kansas City, Missouri. Cumulus also has an interest in the entity seeking a transfer of station KCHZ, Channel 239C1, Ottawa, Kansas.¹ Since the New FM is not in a rated market, but does have overlap with other attributable stations, a revised contour overlap analysis is needed. Based on these facilities and their respective city grade contours, two distinct overlap markets are created. Market #1 consists of AM stations KTOP and KMAJ and FM stations New FM, KDVV, KQPT and KCHZ. Market #2 consists of AM station KCMO and FM stations New FM and KCHZ. Exhibit #1 is a map depicting the subject stations.

1) Cumulus also has interests in KWIC, Channel 257C3, Topeka, Kansas; KCMO-FM, Channel 235C0, Kansas City, Missouri; KMJK, Channel 297C, Lexington, Missouri; KCJK, Channel 286C1, Garden City, Missouri and KCFX, Channel 266C0, Harrisonville, Missouri. As the proposed New FM station does not have city grade overlap with any of these stations, they are not considered further.

2. A study, therefore, has been conducted to determine if ownership of these facilities complies with §73.3555 of the Commission's rules. As the city grade contour of KCHZ is a subject station in both markets, we will determine the number of contributing stations which have sites within, or provide city grade service to, the KCHZ contour. To this total we will then add the relevant subject stations to show compliance in the two markets. Therefore, the KCHZ contour establishes the "Radio Market Boundary" for this review. The study will determine the number of other commercial AM and FM stations that either have transmitter sites within or provide coverage to the subject radio market. Only those stations with transmitter sites within 92.0 kilometers will be considered as contributors to the market. No other station in which Cumulus has interests will be considered, unless it is a subject station in the market under review.

3. Exhibit #2 is a depiction of the non-subject contributing stations within, or providing service to, the KCHZ Radio Market boundary. A total of eleven stations are depicted. Exhibit #3 is a tabulation of the stations in Radio Market #1, which, including the six subject stations, totals seventeen stations. The number of stations depicted falls in the fifteen to twenty nine stations tier of §73.3555(a)(1)(iii) of the Commission's rules.² At the fifteen to twenty-nine stations level, common ownership or control of up to six stations is allowed, with no more than four in the same service. As such, Market #1 is in compliance.

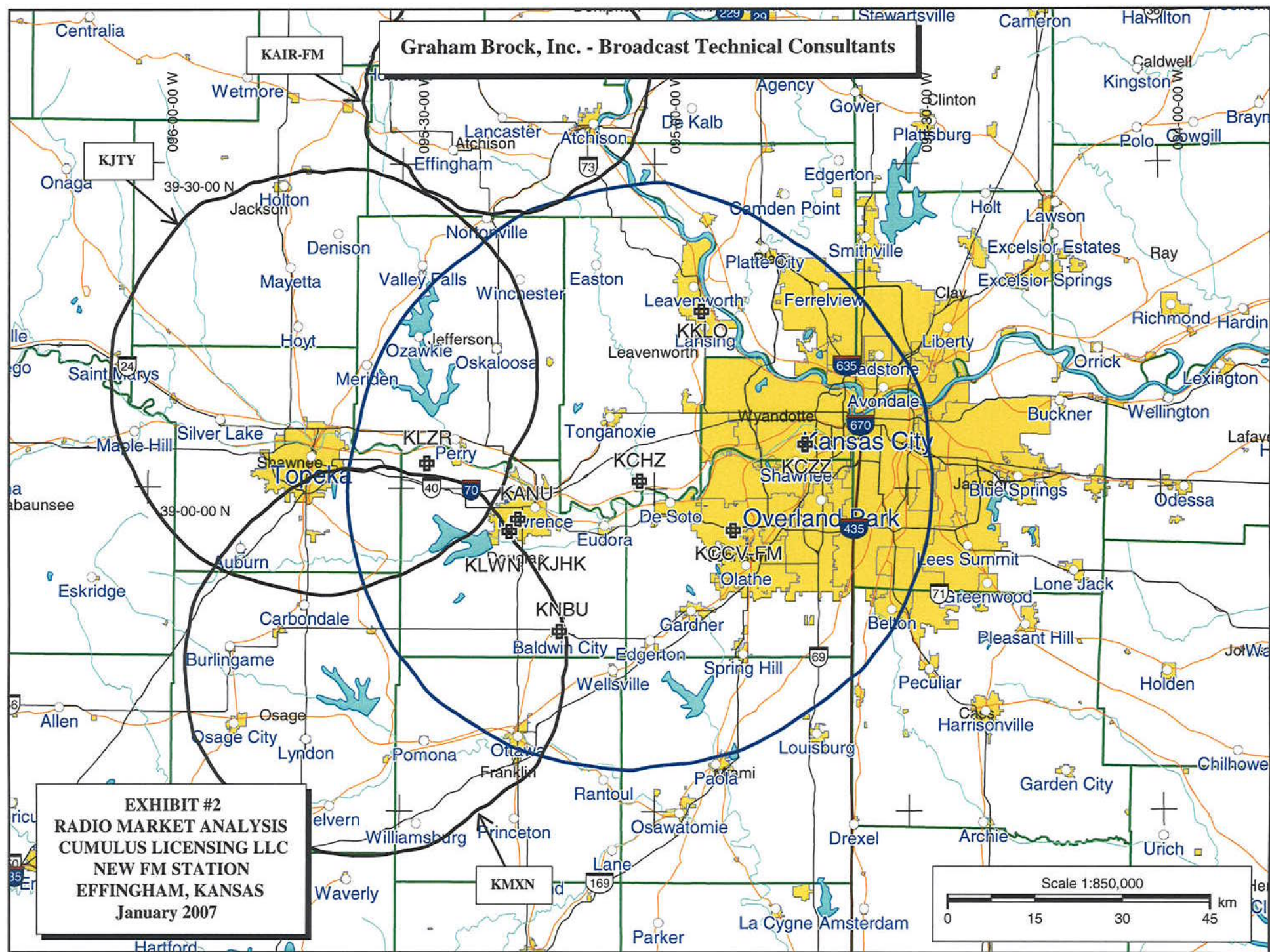
2) There are additional stations, however they were not considered as the number of stations shown were sufficient to demonstrate compliance, based on the number of stations to be commonly held.

4. Exhibit #4 is a tabulation of the stations in the Radio Market #2, which, including the three subject stations, totals fourteen stations. The number of stations depicted falls in the fourteen or fewer stations tier of §73.3555(a)(1)(iv) of the Commission's rules.³ At the fourteen or fewer stations level, common ownership or control of up to five stations is allowed, with no more than three in the same service, provided the number to be commonly held does not exceed 50% of the stations in the market. As such, Market #2 is in compliance with the rules.

5. Based on Cumulus's interests in the above referenced stations in two markets, it is demonstrated herein that the proposed change of community of license for the New FM station is in compliance with the Commission's multiple ownership rules, as detailed in §73.3555 of the rules.

His qualifications are a matter of record before the Federal Communications Commission. He has been active in Broadcast Engineering since 1979.


