Dear Petitioner,

This concerns the above-referenced Petition for Reconsideration seeking reinstatement of the Station's construction permit, facility, and waiver to proceed with the filing of an application for license to cover filed by Christian Broadcasting of Yakima (CBY). In its Petition, filed on September 10, 2021, CBY acknowledges that it failed to file an application for license to cover by the station's construction permit expiration date (July 13, 2022), however CBY states that the station was in fact constructed by that date. On January 19, 2022, Media Bureau (Bureau) staff sent an e-mail requesting additional information in support of the claims made by CBY in its Petition. Following that initial e-mail, Bureau staff has sent numerous follow-up e-mails, but despite CBY's assurances the necessary documentation has yet to be filed with the Commission.¹

By this letter CBY is being provided 10 days from the date of this letter to file in LMS a supplement to its Petition including documentation demonstrating that the station was constructed in accordance with the parameter of its construction permit (LMS File No. 0000028952) on or before July 13, 2021. A copy of the supplement should also be e-mailed to Shaun Maher at the e-mail address listed below. As part of its supplement CBY must include evidence of construction, including pictures of the constructed facility, invoices for equipment purchased and installations conducted, copies of any tower lease agreements, an affidavit signed under penalty of perjury from a person with direct knowledge that the facility was constructed in accordance with the underlying construction permit, and any other documentation that would support CBY's claims in the Petition.

Failure to submit this information within 10 days of the date of this letter will result in the dismissal of the Petition.² For questions or additional information on this matter, please contact Shaun Maher, Video Division, Media Bureau at 202-418-2324 or Shaun.Maher@fcc.gov.
