


AGREEMENT

This will memorialize the understanding reached between Megahertz Licenses, LLC, licensee of Radio Station WXOT(FM), Mount Union, Pennsylvania and Forever Broadcasting, LLC, licensee of Radio Station WWOT(FM), Altoona, Pennsylvania (collectively, "the Parties").

WXOT(FM) desires to apply to the Federal Communication Commission ("FCC") for a minor modification of its broadcast station license, pursuant to MB Docket No. 03-231, to specify a change of community of license to Centre Hall, Pennsylvania, a new transmitter site, and an upgrade in its classification from Class A to Class B1 and other changes. In order for WXOT(FM) to secure an authorization from the FCC, WWOT(FM) must file an application requesting that its transmitter site be relocated and a downgrade from Class B1 to Class A. WWOT(FM) is willing to cooperate with WXOT(FM) and seek a modification so that WXOT(FM) may proceed to secure the relief it seeks. In order to comply with the rules and regulations of the FCC, the requested contingent applications of WXOT(FM), for a minor modification of its operating facilities, and WWOT(FM), for a minor modification of operating facilities, must be filed simultaneously under the procedures set forth in Section 73.3517(e) of the Commission's Rules. Section 73.3517(e) further provides that the parties to such a coordinated facilities modification must undertake their effort pursuant to a written understanding.


