Gentlemen:

This is with respect to the above-captioned application for consent to the assignment of license of Class A television station WNGT-LP, Toledo, Ohio from Ralph Denune III – Receiver for L & M Video Productions, Inc. to Matrix Broadcast Media, Inc. LaMaree Miller filed a petition to deny, which is opposed.

We are unable to complete our review of the proposed assignment at this time. When a Commission licensee is a court appointed receiver, we require that any application to assign or transfer station assets from the receiver to another entity include a certified copy of the court order approving the sale of the station assets to the entity named as the assignee. Thus, we request that you submit a certified court order within 30 days from the date of this letter. In addition, please amend the application as required by the Instructions for Section I of Form 314. Failure to do so may result in dismissal of the assignment application.
