Mr. Nelson,

This email is the official grant of your request for waiver of Section 73.3580, filed in conjunction with the modification application for WSPY(AM), BP-20200508AAR.

In light of the upcoming changes to the existing rule, and the pandemic preventing access to local libraries and town halls, we HEREBY GRANT the requested waiver of Section 73.3580. As a condition of this grant, the licensee of WSPY(AM) must provide a link to WSPY(AM)'s online public file (OPIF) in the newspaper. Any such announcement must also explain that anyone without Internet access can call the station to get a paper copy. Any newspaper publication should include language similar to the following:

Because the COVID-19 pandemic has forced the closing of public places in Geneva and Somonauk where a copy of the application would be placed for public inspection, pursuant to FCC waiver dated June 4, 2020, anyone wishing to view the application may do so by accessing the application at WSPY's Online Public Inspection file at <https://publicfiles.fcc.gov/am-profile/wspy>. Those without Internet access may request that a copy be mailed to them by contacting the licensee, Nelson Multimedia, at (630) 552-1000.
