
This is written on behalf of KJLA, LLC ("KJLA"), the licensee of Station KJLA-DT, Digital Channel 49, Ventura, California (FIN: 14000).

KJLA has been advised that Biltmore Broadcasting Santa Barbara, Inc. ("Biltmore"), the licensee of Station KBAB-LP, Santa Barbara, California, has filed with the FCC an application that requests a displacement authorization to operate on Channel 50 at Santa Barbara, California.

In connection with that application, KJLA is aware that the operation of Biltmore's LPTV Station can be expected to cause 1% interference to the operation of KJLA-DT on Channel 49. KJLA has reviewed this matter with its engineering consultant and understands that the area of interference is not material.

Considering the limited impact on KJLA-DT of the LPTV proposal of Biltmore at Santa Barbara, which includes the retransmission of KJLA's broadcast signal in the Santa Barbara DMA, KJLA wishes to confirm that it has no objection to the request Biltmore has made for modification of the license of KBAB-LP to operate on Channel 50 at Santa Barbara, California and it urges the immediate grant of the Biltmore application.
