Fine Arts Radio, Inc. proposes to build an FM translator station at Newport, Ohio, to operate on Channel 240, 95.9 MHz, and re-broadcast noncommercial, educational FM station WMRT, Marietta, Ohio. WMRT operates on non-commercial, reserved band channel 202, 88.3 MHz., and is licensed to Marietta College.

This exhibit demonstrates that the proposed translator meets all the requirements of Sec. 74.1204. Table I lists the distances to co-channel and adjacent channel stations. Attached as separate exhibits are maps showing the protected contours of adjacent channel stations WVVP-LP, 96.1 Marietta; and WJKW; 95.9 Athens. The first map shows the 54 dbu contour of the proposed translator, and the 60 dbu contour of WVVP-LP; the second map, the 40 dbu contour of the proposed translator and the protected 60 dbu contour of WJKW.
