NCE FM Interference to TV 6
Beckley, West Virginia

The purpose of this exhibit is to show compliance with §73.525 of the Commission's Rules. The Rules require that an applicant proposing operation on FM Channel 201 must be 265 kilometers from a television Channel 6 facility. There are five affected TV 6 stations.

1. WDTV - 176 km distant
2. WDTV-DT - 176 km distant
3. W06AD - 206 km distant
4. W06AL - 251 km distant
5. W06AQ - 260 km distant

First, the relative HAAT figures were generated for the above stations using the NGDC 30 Second Database and the data from the FCC TV Database. The distance to the 47 dBu contour was predicted according to the procedures specified in §73.684 of the Commission's Rules, "Prediction of Coverage," using the F(50,50) curves in Figure 9 of §73.699.

The applicant chooses to use circular polarization and adjustments for vertical only polarization or television receiving antenna directivity have not been utilized.

A table of the proposed NCE-FM F(50,10) interfering contour to the Television Channel 6 F(50,50) protected contours may be seen as Table 1 of this exhibit.

A plot of the proposed NCE-FM stations' 48 dBu F(50,10) interfering contour to television channel 6 47 dBu F(50,50) protected contour may be seen as Figure 1 of this exhibit, note that these contours do not overlap. Therefore, it may be concluded that the proposed NCE FM station will not cause any interference to the reception of TV-6, and the application complies with §73.525 of the Commission's Rules as pertains to interference to the reception of TV Channel 6 by NCE-FM stations.

The applicant has also included a concurrence letter from former TV 6 station WVVA. WVVA is no longer broadcasting on analog channel 6 and are now broadcasting on digital channel 46.
