TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Broadcast South, Inc. (“BSI”), licensee of radio station WVOH-FM, Channel 228C3, Hazlehurst, Georgia. BSI holds an outstanding permit which authorizes an upgrade to Channel 228C2 for WNRJ with a change of city of license to Nicholls, Georgia (BMPH-20101102ABT). BSI herein submits a license application to cover the outstanding permit. A calculation of the transmitter power output of the WVOH-FM transmitter is attached as Exhibit A.

The WVOH-FM permit indicates a center of radiation at 140.0 meters above ground level. However, when the antenna was installed, it was necessary for the center of radiation to be lowered to 137.1 meters above ground level in order to complete the installation.¹

There are two conditions/restrictions on the WVOH-FM permit. Condition #1 states that the permit for the facility was granted pursuant to §73.215 of the Commission’s rules. BSI acknowledges this condition. The second condition states that BSI must reduce the power of WVOH-FM, or cease operation in coordination with other users of the tower, to protect persons

having access to the site from radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines. BSI will comply with this condition.

Based on the foregoing, it is believed that WVOH-FM is in compliance with the Commission's rules and that all conditions have been met.
