License Renewal Applications

Dear Mr. Morgan:

This letter refers to the pending license renewal applications (“Application”) of Radio Lake Placid (“Licensee”) for Stations WLPW(AM) and WIRD(AM), Lake Placid, New York. In addition for Station WRGR(FM), Tupper Lake, New York. We cannot process the Applications and have been holding it since February 24, 2014, pursuant to the Commission’s “red light” rules, which prohibit the staff from granting an application when an applicant is delinquent on debts owed to the Commission.¹ We believe that it is not in the public interest to retain unprocessable applications for extended periods of time, particularly when the extended delay is the result of the inaction of an applicant to correct a debt delinquency.²

Accordingly, we are providing the Licensee a period of 30 days from the date of this letter to pay

or arrange for payment of the delinquent debt with the Commission's Office of Managing Director.³ Failure to have the "red light" status removed within that time period will result in the dismissal of the referenced applications pursuant to Sections 1.1910(b)(3) and 73.3568(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules.⁴ Licensee should send electronic notification on the date said payment is made to Penelope Dade at Penelope.Dade@fcc.gov and Karen Workeman at Karen.Workeman@fcc.gov. Failure to do so will result in additional delay of processing the application.
