SECTION 73.1680 NOTIFICATION OF EMERGENCY ANTENNA OPERATIONS

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of **MacDonald Garber Broadcasting, Inc. ("MGB")**, Licensee of **Radio Station WLXT-FM at Petoskey, Michigan**, we hereby provide § 73.1680 notification that WLXT-FM is currently operating with an emergency antenna system.

By way of background, on January 18, 2011, MGB filed a Request for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to operate at reduced power due to an antenna malfunction. That STA Request (BSTA-20110118ACV) was granted on January 25, 2011. Unfortunately late last week the WLXT antenna completely failed, and an emergency antenna was installed to keep the station on-air.

Currently WLXT is operating with a 2-bay Jampro, with a center of radiation at 270 feet above ground. Unity gain. The TPO is 12 kilowatts. The ERP is also at 12 kilowatts.

On or about February 28, 2011, a different emergency antenna will be installed at the same center of radiation. This will be a 2-bay ERI SHP2AE Rototiller. Unity gain. The TPO will be 25 kilowatts and the ERP will be 25 kilowatts.

The coverage area of WLXT using the Jampro emergency antenna does not extend beyond the licensed coverage area. Likewise, future use of the ERI emergency antenna will not provide coverage beyond the license coverage area.
