### MIDWEST

1870 - First all woman jury.

July 1880 - Oil seeps reported in north end of field. Reported by Indians.

1889 - First drilling and discovery of oil in Shannon pool.

Oct. 21, 1908 - First well drilled in Midwest. First well was #15 on SE 1/4 section 23-40-79.

1910 - First camp was Dutch Camp. Tar paper shacks & tents.

1918 - Wooden pipe line from Tisdale Mountain to Castle Rock tanks. 133,000 barrels flowed through it a day.  
First Church in Midwest.

1920 - Artesian well - cooled at the cooling pond & used for gardens & toilets.  
Midwest Refinery.  
Had soccer, golf, tennis court, football field, baseball, & Legion activities.

1921 - First water right from the Platte river.

1922 - Gas torch lit, 125' high & seen as far as 50 miles. It burned off poisonous gases. The torch was put out in 1928, at which time there had been three such torches in the field.  
First welded pipeline in the world - each pipe was 40' long.  
Club house & Lodge.

Feb. 1923 - Town of Salt Creek built by Kittleson.

1923 - Mrs. Patterson (Carla Jensen's mother) had the first scout

troop.

The railroad was built through Salt Creek. It was torn down in 1935.

Feb. 2, 1924 - Hospital & Nurses quarters built. Hospital insurance \$1.00.

1924 - Electric Plant was built.  
First electrified oil field.

Nov. 19, 1925 - First night lighted football game in the United States.  
Midwest vs. Casper, 0 - 19.

1926 - Haydite plant built. Made from shale & cement. It was used to make corner stones for every derrick. It was made only in the Salt Creek field.

The Town of Salt Creek was built.

1927 - Old Cookhouse moved from Fitzhugh Avenue to Ellison Avenue.

Schools torn down - gym built.

1928 - Electricity was introduced into some Salt Creek homes.

1929 - Dick Brodrick - named the football team the Oilers.

Aug. 1930 - Part of Salt Creek burned down.

1937 - Hospital closed.

1937 - Stanolind oilfield office moved into hospital.

1940 - Oil field offices moved into the hospital building.

1940 - 1958 - Pan Am offices in old hospital, than moved to Casper.

1948 - Old cook house burned down.

1950 - Wilson building torn down, grade school.

1953 - Old grade school torn down. New grade school was built.

1959 - Electric row was the last camp that moved to Midwest.

1959 - The Electric Plant was torn down (Frank Shepperson owns it).

1960 - Over six million people worked here. Residents purchased their homes from the Oil Co.

High School was torn down.

1961 - Theater torn down.  
New School was built.

1963 - Old gym torn down - built in 1927.

1971 - Amoco.

1975 - Elwanda Burk - Justice of the Peace.

1975 - 1979 - Elwanda Burk - Mayor.

1978 - Midwest became incorporated.

1978 - Senior Citizens incorporated & moved into the old hospital

1979 - Pauline Schultz had the first Senior Citizens flag made in the United States.

1979 - John Griffin - Mayor.

1979 - 1982 - Jack Officer - Mayor.

1980 - Salt Creek Museum opened in the old Hospital.

1982 - 1984 - Twyla Eldridge - Mayor.

1984 - 1990 - Everett Chaffin - Mayor.

1990 - 1998 - John VanderVoort - Mayor.

1994 - Salt Creek Museum moved to the old Clinic.

1997 - Second water pipeline from Casper to Midwest was completed.

1998 - Howell Petroleum took over Amoco.

1998 - 1999 - Bud Dimick - Mayor.

1999 -2002 Mary O'Connor - Mayor.

2002 - Guy Chapman - Mayor.

2002 - Anadarko acquired Howell Corporation. Located within the Salt Creek Field at a purchase price of \$265,000,000.

Spring 2003 - Anadarko started the CO2 Pilot.

Jan. 2004 - Anadarko's first injection of CO2 in the full field development project.

May 2004 - First Oil Sales from CO2 Flood.

### Bar Nunn

Bar Nunn's estimated 936 residents live about five miles northwest of Casper. The town was incorporated in 1982, and is governed by an elected mayor and four elected town council members. The appointed Parks and Recreation Committee and a Zoning and Planning Commission assist in the planning and beautification of the community. The town has four full-time employees.

Law enforcement for the Town of Bar Nunn is provided by a resident deputy through contact with the Natrona County Sheriff's Department. Building and safety code enforcement are provided under contact with the City of Casper. Trash collection is contracted out, with the Town collecting residents' payments.

All Bar Nunn residents are connected to the City of Casper regional water project, billed by Wardwell Water and Sewer District. All homes in Bar Nunn are connected to the Bar Nunn waste water system, which empties into the City of Casper's 201 line for transport to Casper for processing. Most homes are all electric with options for natural gas service. The newest housing development in Bar Nunn, the McMurry #1 Addition is connected to natural gas. This subdivision offers fairly affordable homes.

Bar Nunn is growing, offering its residents quality licensed daycare facilities, an elementary school (preschool through sixth grade,) a top-rated volunteer fire department and three beautifully landscaped and maintained parks. Bar Nunn is a Tree City USA community and has a newly constructed Baptist church. The KOA Campground operates a 3-hole miniature golf course and an indoor pool, which are available to town residents as well as to KOA visitors. Most of the town's residents staked their claims in Bar Nunn several years ago, but there's plenty of room for you, too! Many available Bar Nunn building lots are 100x150, and the McMurry #1 Addition's lots average 80X110.

Bar Nunn's residents have the best of two worlds: a quiet, scenic, landscaped community with access to top-notch shopping and restaurants only minutes away.

### Mills

The Town of Mills began as a home for men who worked at the old Amoco Refinery in 1917 and was incorporated in 1921. With 2,500 people and a significant portion of the industry in Natrona County, the town today provides a good place for people to work and a good place to live, where the residents have easy access to the town council, have control over their own water, and can find affordable housing.

The town has reconstructed all of its streets in the past twenty years using sales tax receipt and grants. With no assessment for the water system, rates are the lowest in the county. There is a new town maintenance shop and new fire hall for the volunteer fire department. The residents are proud to have their own post office and zip code. While the major educational, entertainment and shopping facilities are in Casper, Mills residents have benefited from recent growth in Natrona County's work.

Mills has grown significantly in population in the last ten years. The town grew by 500 house lots and 750 people in 1997 through the annexation of portions of the Mountain View businesses and residential areas annexing allowing for affordable utilities.

### Evansville

The town of Evansville (population 2,255; Census 2000) sits directly northeast of the city of Casper, enjoying the benefits of both small-town living at home and access to big city amenities. A May 15, 1923 election incorporated the town.

In present day Evansville, John Richard (Reshaw) constructed a wooden toll bridge. The bridge was used from 1852-1865 to provide additional access to emigrants and other travelers. Two temporary military camps, Camp Clay and Camp Payne,

occupied the site at Reshaw's bridge. The camps were abandoned in November 1856. You can encounter the abundant wildlife of the area on the Town's walking path at this historical site.

Evansville has a full-time Police Department, and Volunteer Fire and Ambulance Service.

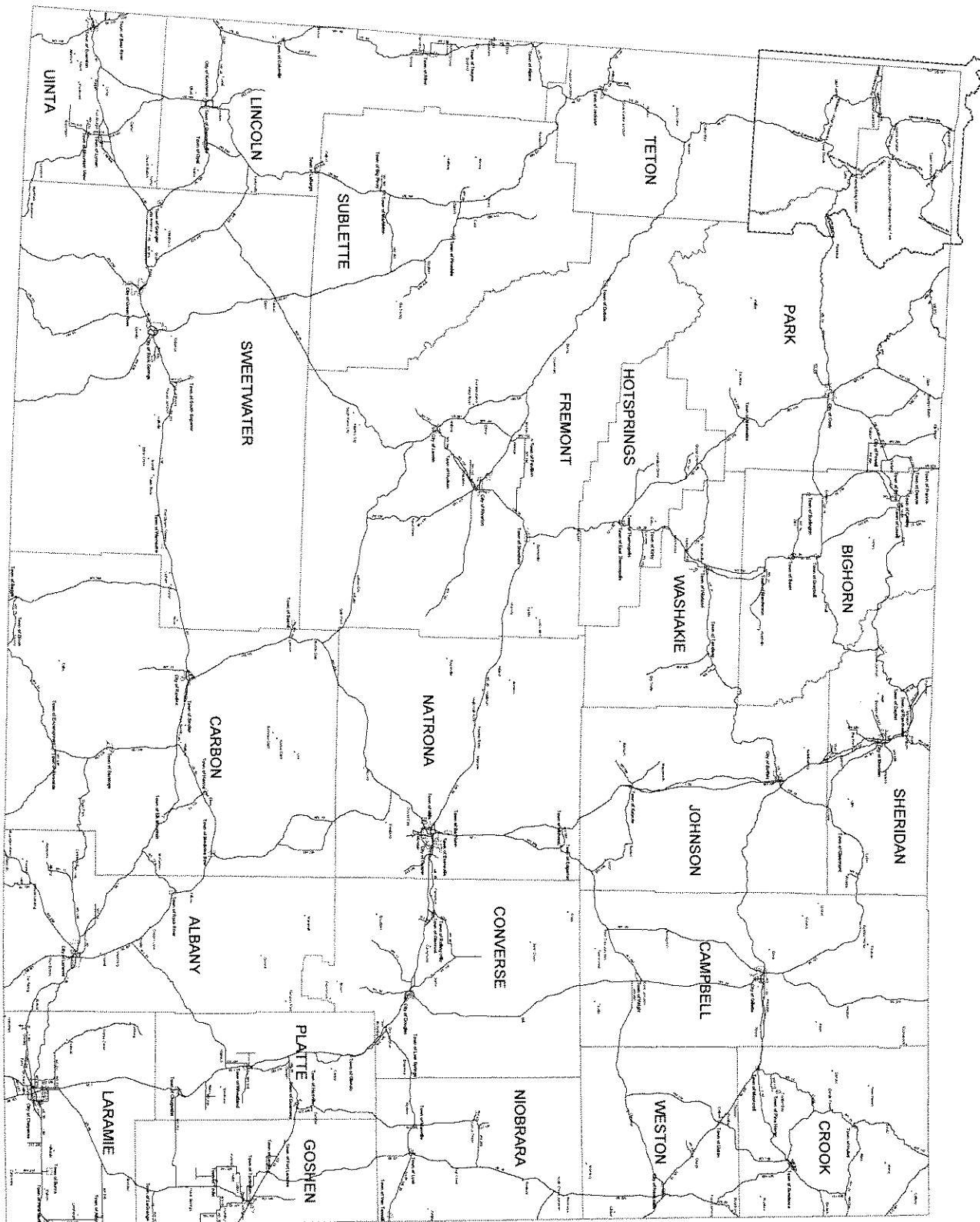

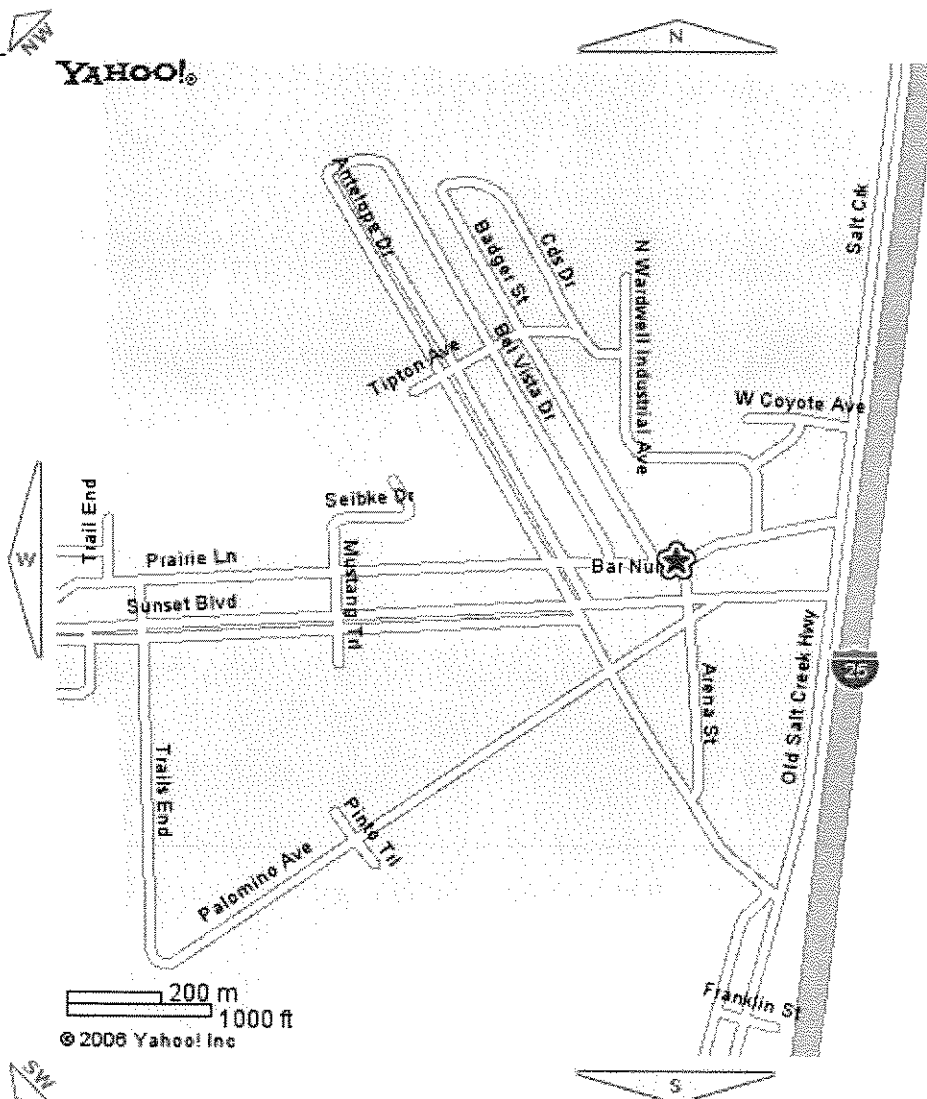

## HISTORY OF THE TOWN OF BAR NUNN

The Town of Bar Nunn is located five miles northwest of Casper. Romie Nunn, a local rancher and successful businessman, moved to Casper in 1918. He purchased what is now the Town of Bar Nunn in 1954. The property was the old Wardwell Field, Natrona County's airport until 1952, when the county purchased the United States Army Air Corps Base where the present International Airport is located. Mr. Nunn purchased the property (consisting of 640 acres) in 1954 for \$20,500.00, and hoped to make it "the horse center of the Rockies." In 1958 he subdivided the area, calling it the Bar-Nunn Ranch Subdivision. In 1959 a Denver publication referred to Mr. Nunn as "The Runway Rancher", saying: "When you buy a ranch and build an airport on it, that is one thing. But when you buy an airport and make a ranch out of it, that's Wyoming!"

Mr. Nunn passed away in 1988, never being able to realize his dream about the "horse center," but the town was named for him when incorporated February 4, 1982. Mr. Nunn designed, applied for and received a brand from the Livestock and Sanitary Board in May 1958. The design on the brand is a symbol of a "dash" and a capital "N" (---N), thus the name Bar Nunn.

Population count for the town was 936 for the year of 2000 which I think even at that time was incorrect. I believe our population is approximately 2000 at this time due to 297 stick built homes now being built of which approximately 260 are already occupied. The town has a mayor, council form of government consisting of a mayor and four council members. The mayors in first order were: Carol Tipton, Steve Gilland, Chuck Anderson and our present mayor, Jerry Petty. Council meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 P.M.

Town Hall employs four people, Chuck and Jack in maintenance and Kathleen and Carol as Clerk Treasurer-Court Clerk and Deputy Clerk Treasurer respectively in the office. A resident deputy contracted through the Natrona County Sheriff's Department does the police work for the town. I hold court once a month for people who have received citations in our town. Animal control is done through Metro Animal Control of Casper. An enforcement officer from Casper is also contracted to cite people for various problems such as weeds, inoperable vehicles, and anything else which would make our town appear "unkept." We also have a contract with the City of Casper which allows us to employ them for inspections on additions to existing homes, new and remodeling homes. At Town Hall, we issue building permits, bill for sewer and garbage, do accounts receivable, accounts payable, payroll, publish a monthly newsletter, and all other work as assigned ( am sure everyone has heard that phrase.) As Clerk Treasurer one of my duties is to attend council meetings and work sessions and record the minutes, which are then kept in a minute book at Town Hall. We have our ordinances codified by Sterling Codifiers.

There is one elementary school in which the first class was held in 1983. It consists of kindergarten through grade six. Children past elementary level are taken by bus to Casper schools. The streets were built upon the old runways of the airport. We have been a "Tree City USA" for the past thirteen years. Volunteers have planted over 1,000 trees in the past thirteen years. Medians have been landscaped with grass and trees. There are three parks in the town which are known as Antelope Territory, Romie Nunn, and

Heritage. The Fire Hall located at 1705 Sunset Boulevard was built in 1989 and consists of 22 active members.

Bar Nunn was first listed in the Rand McNally Road Atlas in 1989. It was also listed in the book written by Neil Swanson, named "ODD & PECULIAR", the most unusual name of a Town/Village/City in Each of the Fifty States and copyrighted in 1996.

Bar Nunn was one of the first towns to become ADA compliant. The Town Hall and Council Chambers were remodeled in 1990 by Chuck and Jack ( our maintenance men.) A swamp cooler was used for many years, then we upgraded to central air. (thank goodness.) The medians consist of roughly 13.50 acres and have sprinkler systems installed in all of them. The three parks consist of 8 acres, which also have sprinkler systems. Grass has been planted in all medians and parks. Children play area equipment is located in two of the largest parks, one of which has two huge covered picnic shelters with outdoor grills and picnic tables plus it has an adult exercise fitness system. Our regulation ball field is used a great deal of times by residents and sometime by people from the City of Casper. There are two regulation size tennis courts.

I think Bar Nunn is the only town in Wyoming which has street signs that read "ANTELOPE CROSSING" as we have an abundance of them. They come into the town by the groups when it gets close to hunting season plus they stay here year round. We really enjoy watching them, especially the newborn babies.

It is the only town where people backing out of their driveways must look right, look left and then look up. We have in the past had planes land on our streets as they somewhat yet resemble runways.
