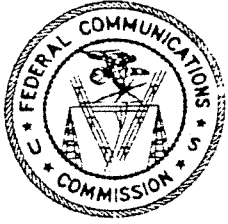

**INTERTECH MEDIA, LLC**  
**INTERNET SITE LICENSE AGREEMENT**

This Agreement ("Agreement"), dated March 1, 2003 (the "Effective Date"), is by and between InterTech Media, LLC ("InterTech"), a Delaware limited liability company with its principal office located at 1111 East Putnam Ave., Riverside, CT 06878, and Salisbury Broadcasting-Colorado, LLC., a Colorado corporation, with a principal office located at 1400 Easton Drive, Suite 129, Bakersfield, CA 93309 ("Licensee").

WHEREAS, Licensee desires to establish Internet sites relating to its radio stations (the "Stations") and serving the cities set forth in Schedule 1 (the "Territories" or each as a "Territory" in the singular) by providing information with respect to entertainment, cultural, dining, lodging and other activities with respect to each Territory; and

WHEREAS, Licensee operates the Stations listed in Schedule 1 that target the formats set forth in such Schedule 1 (the format associated with each Station, as set out in Schedule 1, being referred to herein as the "Licensed Format"),

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Grant.** Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, InterTech grants the following to Licensee during the Term of this Agreement: (a) the exclusive right to link the URLs set out in Schedule 1 to InterTech's servers to exhibit, transmit, and display the Licensed Sites and (b) access to InterTech's Servers (including servers owned, operated, or licensed by InterTech) as may be reasonably necessary to permit Licensee to upload, select and change the content to appear on the Licensed Sites. Except as set forth herein, no copying, dissemination, publication, display or distribution in any form of the InterTech Content or InterTech Marks, in whole or in part, by Licensee is permitted without the prior written consent of InterTech. InterTech will be Licensee's exclusive provider for the services described in this Agreement.
2. **Payments Due to InterTech.** For the rights granted by InterTech to Licensee hereunder and for the services to be provided by InterTech to Licensee hereunder, Licensee shall pay to InterTech on a monthly basis, 1) [REDACTED] per station, payable, in advance, on the first day of each month, 2) the prices listed in Schedule 2 for Licensee utilization of any of the services listed in Schedule 2, and 3) an amount specified by InterTech for any other services rendered and not set forth in Schedule 2. Prices paid by each Station are based on the Station's assigned Pricing Group as set forth in Schedule 1. The Pricing Groups set forth in Schedule 1 may be changed from time to time by InterTech with written notice to Licensee. Services are deemed rendered to Licensee when Licensee places a business name, description, banner, sponsorship, product mention, logo or any other business information for any business in any location on a Licensed Site.
3. **Payments Due to Licensee.** If InterTech posts any advertising of the variety set forth in Part 1 of Schedule 2 on any Licensed Site and such advertising is displayed in one city only, InterTech will pay to Licensee the amounts listed in Part 1 of Schedule 2 for such advertising. If InterTech posts a video or audio ad that is displayed only in one city, InterTech will pay to Licensee 40% of the prices listed in Part 2 of Schedule 2 for such advertising. Any advertising originated by InterTech or its representatives that is displayed in more than one city is solely for the benefit of InterTech.
4. **Advertising Locations and Rates.** Licensee shall have three (3) advertising banner locations sized 120X90 pixels into which Licensee may place advertising banners that will run in rotation in these locations. Licensee shall have the non-exclusive use of one of the banners sized 234X60 pixels to enter

banners that will run in rotation at that position. Amounts owed by Licensee to InterTech for utilizing these advertising locations shall be as set forth in Schedule 2 attached hereto, payable as set forth in paragraph 2 above. All other advertising locations shall be allocated by InterTech at its sole discretion. Schedule 3 sets forth the recommended rates at which Licensee may resell the various advertising positions.

5. **Overage Charges.** Licensee shall be allotted 500 megabytes of storage space per station on InterTech's Servers. Storage in excess of such allotted space shall be charged to the Licensed Sites at a rate equivalent to the rate then currently paid by InterTech for similar storage at its co-location facility.

6. **Licensee Promotional Commitment.** In consideration of the rights granted by InterTech to Licensee, Licensee hereby commits to make available weekly to InterTech 25 one-minute advertising spots in the best available time slots during the period of 6:00 AM until 12:00 midnight on each Station. The content of these advertising spots shall be determined solely by InterTech. Licensee will provide InterTech with verification, by affidavit, that such spots were aired on each Station. <sup>and the management of the stations.</sup> *CMS*

7. **Payments.** Payment attributable to a calendar month shall be due no later than twenty days following the end of such month. Payment shall be accompanied by a detailed statement of the services utilized broken down on a per Licensed Site basis. The amounts due under this Agreement will be paid by Licensee to InterTech in full without any right of set-off or deduction. If payment is not made by Licensee within 15 Business Days of the due date thereof, then InterTech may immediately (a) remove any and all Licensee-related material from its servers or from servers under InterTech's control, and/or (b) suspend the performance of its obligations under or terminate the Agreement. If InterTech suspends the performance of its obligations under the Agreement in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph, Licensee shall continue to be liable to InterTech for all amounts due pursuant to the Agreement the same as if no such suspension had taken place and InterTech had fully performed its obligations hereunder. Reinstatement of service will then be at the discretion of InterTech.

8. **Third Party Branding.** If all or any part of InterTech Content licensed at any time to Licensee includes content obtained from a Third Party Provider, Licensee shall, at InterTech's request comply with such requests of InterTech as may be reasonably intended to ensure compliance by Licensee with InterTech's obligations to such Third Party Provider.

9. **Intellectual Property Rights.** Licensee is the sole owner of all right, title and interest in and to any Licensee-Owned Content and to any Licensee's trade or service marks ("Licensee's Marks") used on or incorporated into the Licensed Sites. InterTech exclusively owns all Intellectual Property Rights in the Licensed Sites, the InterTech Content, the InterTech Marks, and any software or algorithm provided to Licensee by InterTech, and that Licensee gains no rights in the same, except as explicitly set forth herein. In particular, InterTech is the sole owner of all right, title and interest in the copyright and other property interests in the works authored by InterTech pursuant to the Agreement. The parties agree that no work produced by InterTech under the Agreement shall be considered "work made for hire" as that term is understood under the copyright law of the United States, 17 U.S.C. §§ 101 et seq., so that all copyright and other property interest in the works produced by InterTech shall vest at the time of their creation in InterTech, and Licensee shall have no copyright or other property interest in any works produced under the Agreement. All Intellectual Property Rights in any intellectual property, whether now existing or which may hereafter come into existence, which are not expressly granted to Licensee herein are reserved to InterTech. To the extent that any InterTech Intellectual Property Rights may, by operation of law or otherwise, vest in Licensee, Licensee will, at the request and expense of InterTech, irrevocably assign to InterTech any and all such right, title or interest including, where applicable, all of the exclusive rights under copyright law. Licensee agrees to execute and deliver to InterTech such assignments or other instruments as InterTech may require from time to time to evidence InterTech's ownership of such copyright and the results and proceeds of InterTech's services. Licensee agrees that InterTech shall be free

to provide technical information and/or intellectual property rights provided to or used by Licensee pursuant to this Agreement to other parties and shall retain the right to unrestricted use of any information regarding generalized data, any and all related areas or concepts, know-how techniques, general information and/or intellectual property rights either gained or developed as a result of this Agreement. Each party understands that the other may use the work produced pursuant to the Agreement (including each party's Content) for its own marketing or promotional purposes and, for that limited purpose, each party hereby grants to the other a license to use such party's Content and Marks. Such licenses will be revoked by the termination of the Agreement. The parties acknowledge that the licenses provided for shall in no way transfer any good will associated with the Marks.

10. **InterTech and Licensee Content.** InterTech reserves for itself complete editorial freedom in the form and content of the InterTech Content and may alter the same from time to time. In the event Licensee makes any correction, change, revision, addition, deletion, rearrangement, improvement or other modification ("Licensee's Modification") to the InterTech Content Licensee agrees that InterTech shall be deemed the sole author of the work so produced and its attendant intellectual property rights. InterTech retains the right to reject for any reason any Licensee Content for display on the Licensed Sites. Licensee and InterTech each assume full and complete responsibility and liability for their own Content, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the other against any demands, claims, or liability arising therefrom; provided that if the content is obtained from a Third Party Provider, the indemnifying party's only obligation to the other will be to assign to the other party the indemnity, if any, which the indemnifying party receives from the Third Party Provider. Except as otherwise herein specifically provided or unless made with the prior written consent of the party who owns the content, neither party may sublicense, assign, copy, distribute, modify, merge, and transfer the Content of the other. The provisions of this paragraph shall remain effective and inure to the benefit of the parties notwithstanding the expiration, cancellation, or termination of the Agreement.

11. **Linking, Framing and Co-Branding.** Licensee may not permit other Internet sites or online services to use an URL, icon, logo, highlighted or colored text, figure or image representing a URL to point and click, or otherwise send a command, to access InterTech Content on the Licensed Sites without the prior written consent of InterTech. To the extent technologically feasible, Licensee shall not permit any third party to frame the Licensed Sites such that any InterTech Content appears on the same screen as a third party's Internet site or on-line service. Licensee shall cooperate with InterTech in causing such third party to cease and desist from such framing. Licensee may not Co-brand the Licensed Sites.

12. **Exclusion of Warranties.** The goods and services provided by InterTech are provided "AS-IS", without warranty of any kind to licensee or any third party, including, but not limited to, any express or implied warranties of: (a) merchantability or merchantability of the computer program; (b) fitness for a particular purpose, licensee's purpose or system integration; (c) effort to achieve purpose; (d) quality; (e) accuracy of informational content; (f) non-infringement; (g) quiet enjoyment; and (h) title. Licensee agrees that any efforts by InterTech to modify its goods or services shall not be deemed a waiver of these limitations, and that any InterTech warranties shall not be deemed to have failed of their essential purpose. Licensee further agrees that InterTech shall not be liable to licensee or any third party for any loss of profits, loss of use, interruption of business, or any direct, indirect, incidental or consequential damages of any kind whether under this agreement or otherwise, even if InterTech was advised of the possibility of such damages or was grossly negligent. Modifications made to licensee's web site by licensee or any third party voids any remaining express or implied warranties and are made at the peril of the licensee. InterTech's liability for all claims of any kind arising out of or related to this agreement, whether based on contract, tort (including without limitation, strict liability and negligence); warranty or on other legal or equitable grounds shall be limited solely to money damages and shall not exceed the amounts paid to InterTech by licensee during the 12 months immediately prior to the date on which the alleged damages were



claimed to have been incurred regardless of the cause or form of act. Each party hereby acknowledges that it has not relied upon any warranty, condition, guaranty or representation made by the other except as specifically set forth in this agreement. Some jurisdictions do not permit the exclusion or limitation of liability for consequential or incidental damages, and, as such, some portion of the above limitation may not apply to Licensee. In such jurisdictions, InterTech's liability is limited to the greatest extent permitted by law.

13. **Disruption of Service.** The parties expressly recognize that Internet servers and links are susceptible to crashes and downtime. InterTech warrants that it shall maintain a consistent link with the Internet, but InterTech cannot and does not warrant that it shall maintain a continuous and uninterrupted link. InterTech does not warrant any response rate or download time. InterTech may, at its own discretion, temporarily suspend all service for the purpose of repair, maintenance or improvement of any of InterTech's systems. Licensee shall not be entitled to any setoff, discount, refund or other credit, in case of any service outage.

14. **Termination Generally.** In addition to any other remedy available at law, in equity, or pursuant to the terms of this Agreement, either party may terminate this Agreement immediately, without further obligation to the other party in the event of any breach of this Agreement by the other party that is not remedied within 30 days' notice of such breach in writing.

15. **Change in Licensed Format; Sale of Station.** Should any of Licensee's Stations ever change its target audience from that described in Schedule 1, Licensee shall immediately advise InterTech in writing of the same. InterTech shall then have thirty days from the date of such notice to accommodate the Station's change in Licensed Format or delete such station from Schedule 1, effective the date given in a written notice to Licensee. Should any of Licensee's Stations be sold to a third party, Licensee shall so advise InterTech in writing. In such case, such Station or Stations shall be considered to have been deleted from Schedule 1 as of the date of the sale.

16. **Rights and Obligations Upon Termination.** After termination by either party for any reason, InterTech shall retain the right to recover all accrued charges due and owing by Licensee to InterTech, and Licensee agrees that it waives any right it may have against InterTech to offset fees payable by Licensee to InterTech. Licensee further agrees to allow advertisers that have contracted with InterTech at the time of termination to continue to advertise on any sites that replace the Licensed Sites for the un-expired term of their agreements with InterTech and allow InterTech to continue to collect amounts owed by these advertisers. Promptly upon termination of this Agreement, each party will (a) delete or destroy any of the other party's Content stored or otherwise in the party's possession, custody or control; (b) cease using the other party's Marks; and (c) pay all payments due to the other party pursuant to this Agreement.

17. **Term.** This Agreement shall take effect on the Effective Date. This Agreement shall continue in effect for one year from such date unless terminated earlier in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. Unless either party gives written notice of its election to terminate this Agreement at least ninety days prior to the end of any one-year period, it shall automatically be renewed for an additional one-year period at the expiration of each period.

18. **Capitalized Terms.** Capitalized terms used in this Agreement shall have the meaning given to such terms in this Agreement or in the schedules, exhibits, and appendices attached hereto.

19. **Similar Agreements.** Nothing will be deemed to limit or restrict InterTech from entering into agreements with any other Person covering services similar to the Licensed Sites or from offering similar services itself; provided, however, InterTech shall not grant to any other person or entity the right to use InterTech Content or InterTech Marks on an Internet site serving the Territory if such person or entity

20. **Controlling Law.** This Agreement will be deemed to have been executed and delivered in the State of Connecticut and it will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Connecticut. The parties hereby consent to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of Connecticut for the purpose of any action or proceeding brought by either of them in connection with this Agreement.

21. **Noncompetition.** During the term of the Agreement and for two years after expiration or termination, Licensee shall not compete with InterTech in the offering of similar web content services.

22. **Assignments.** This Agreement will be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns. Neither party may assign any of its rights or delegate any of its duties under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other, provided that InterTech may assign its rights under the Agreement to any of its Affiliates without the express prior written consent of Licensee. Additionally, InterTech may delegate some or all of its duties to one or more independent contractors of InterTech and/or its Affiliates, provided, however, that InterTech retains control over the results of the services to be rendered by such independent contractor.

23. **Amendments; Waivers.** This Agreement may not be amended, waived, modified or superseded, unless expressly agreed to in writing by both parties. The failure of either party at any time or times to require full performance of any provision hereof will in no manner affect the right of such party at a later time to enforce the same.

24. **Miscellaneous.** This Agreement and any and all addenda, schedules or exhibits attached hereto represent the entire agreement of the parties regarding the subject matter hereof. There are no other oral or written collateral representations, agreements, or understandings regarding the subject matter hereof. If any provision or term of this Agreement, not being of a fundamental nature, is held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remainder of this Agreement will not be affected. If any action at law or in equity, including an action for declaratory relief, is brought to enforce or interpret the provisions of the Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees from the other party. There is no joint venture, partnership, agency or fiduciary relationship existing between the parties and the parties do not intend to create any such relationship by this Agreement. The provisions of Appendix A and Appendix B are hereby incorporated herein the same as they had been copied herein verbatim.

25. **Survival.** The provisions of Paragraphs 2, 3, 9, 10, 16, 21 and the provisions set out in Appendices A and B, and any and all disclaimers and indemnities contained herein or in any Schedules to this Agreement will survive the termination of this Agreement, and shall remain effective and inure to the benefit of the parties for a period of five (5) years following and notwithstanding the expiration, cancellation, or termination of the Agreement.

Upon request, InterTech shall advise Licensee what Intellectual Property licenses it believes, in good faith, may be required, and provide Licensee with complete and accurate copies thereof.
3. **Notice of Indemnification.** A party seeking indemnification pursuant to this Appendix "B" (an "**Indemnified Party**") from or against the assertion of any claim by a third Person (a "**Third Person Assertion**") will give prompt notice to the party from whom indemnification is sought (the "**Indemnifying Party**"); provided, however, that failure to give prompt notice will not relieve the Indemnifying Party of any liability hereunder (except to the extent the Indemnifying Party has suffered actual material prejudice by such failure).
4. **Assumption of Defense.** Within five (5) Business Days of receipt of notice from the Indemnified Party pursuant to Paragraph 3 of this Appendix, the Indemnifying Party will have the right, exercisable by written notice to the Indemnified Party, to assume the defense of a Third Person Assertion. If the Indemnifying Party assumes such defense, the Indemnifying Party may select counsel, which counsel will be reasonably acceptable to the Indemnified Party.




