Because this application is made on channel 210, 47 C.F.R. § 74.1205(a) requires that a showing be provided proving compliance with the other provisions of § 74.1205 if the proposed translator is within 135 km of any channel 6 television station.

Page 2 of this exhibit shows all stations within 135 km. The last column in that tabulation shows the area of overlap in square kilometers of the 73 dB μ F(50,10) interfering contour with any 47 dB μ F(50,50) protected contour.

Page 3 of this exhibit is a letter from KRIS-TV stating that they have objection the operation of this FM Translator in the reserved band.
