The undersigned, constituting all of the directors of ComCorp of Baton Rouge, Inc., a Delaware corporation (the "Company"), hereby waive any and all requirements for the holding of a meeting of the Company's Board of Directors including, without limitation, any requirements as to notice thereof, and acting herein by written consent as permitted by the Delaware General Corporation Law, hereby adopt the following recitals and resolutions:

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of Directors of the Company, it is desirable and in the best interests of the Company, its creditors, and other interested parties that a petition (the "Petition") be filed by the Company seeking relief under the provisions of chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"); therefore it is

RESOLVED, that D. Wayne Elmore, the President and Chief Executive Officer of the Company (the "Authorized Officer"), is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in the name and on behalf of the Company, to: (a) execute and verify the Petition and all other ancillary documents, and to cause the Petition to be filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Louisiana (the "Bankruptcy Court") at such time as said Authorized Officer executing the same shall determine; (b) execute, verify and file or cause to be filed all petitions, schedules, statements, lists, motions, applications and other papers or documents necessary or desirable in connection with the foregoing; and (c) execute and verify any and all other documents necessary or appropriate in connection therewith or to administer the Company's chapter 11 case in such form or forms as such Authorized Officer may approve; and it is further

RESOLVED that the Authorized Officer shall be, and hereby is, authorized, directed and empowered to retain, on behalf of the Company: (a) the law firm of Heller, Draper, Hayden, Patrick & Horn, L.L.C. ("Heller Draper"); and (b) Alvarez & Marsal LLC; and it is further

RESOLVED that the law firm of Heller Draper and any additional special or local counsel selected by the Authorized Officer, if any, shall be, and hereby are, authorized, empowered and directed to represent the Company, as debtor and debtor in possession, in connection with any

chapter 11 case commenced by or against it under the Bankruptcy Code; and it is further


RESOLVED, that the Authorized Officer, and each such other officer of the Company as the Authorized Officer shall from time to time designate, be, and each hereby is authorized and empowered on behalf of, and in the name of, the Company to retain and employ such other attorneys, investment bankers, accountants, restructuring professionals, financial advisors and other professionals to assist the Company in its chapter 11 case on such terms and conditions as are deemed by such Authorized Officer or designee as necessary, proper and desirable; and it is further


RESOLVED, that the Authorized Officer, and each such other officer of the Company as the Authorized Officer shall from time to time designate, and any employees or agents (including counsel) designated by or directed by the Authorized Officer or designee, be, and each hereby is, authorized and empowered to cause the Company to enter into, execute, deliver, certify, file and/or record, implement, effectuate, and perform, as applicable, such agreements, instruments, motions, proceedings, affidavits, applications for approvals or rulings of governmental or regulatory authorities, certificates and other documents, and to take such other actions, as in the judgment of such officer or designee shall deem necessary, proper and desirable to prosecute to a successful completion the chapter 11 case, to effectuate the restructuring of the debt, other obligations, organizational form and structure and ownership of the Company consistent with the foregoing resolutions and to carry out and put into effect the purposes of these resolutions and the transactions contemplated by these resolutions, their authority thereunto to be evidenced by the taking of such actions; and it is further

RESOLVED, that any and all past actions heretofore taken by officers or directors of the Company in the name and on behalf of the Company in furtherance of any or all of these resolutions be, and the same hereby are, ratified, confirmed and approved.

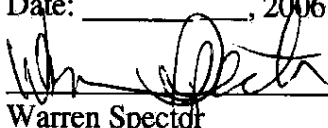
