


CONSENT

Non-Commercial Qualifications

The instant application is filed in connection with an application for assignment of the license for KJAC(FM), Timnath, CO., from Front Range Sports Network, LLC ("Front Range") to Community Radio for Northern Colorado or "CRNC." The purpose is to secure Commission approval for a change in KJAC's status from commercial to non-commercial effective upon the closing of the transaction, and thereby satisfy one of the conditions precedent to consummation. Attached to this Exhibit is authorization from Front Range to file this application.

Community Radio for Northern Colorado holds Commission licenses for five full-service radio broadcast stations, and twelve FM translators, all serving the State of Colorado and all non-commercial. CRNC's licenses were renewed principally in March and May 2013. See, e.g., BRED- 20121 203AVI.

CRNC's mission is to provide educational, news, and cultural programming for citizens of Colorado. Its programming includes, for example, "Morning Edition" and "All Things Considered" from National Public Radio; music; and local news and information. Its non-commercial qualifications are a matter of record with the Commission and Section II of FCC Form 340 is attached.

For the foregoing reasons, the change in KJAC's status to non-commercial educational is requested effective upon the closing.
