

BROADCAST MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP STUDY SUMMARY

CCR-LAMAR IV, LLC & CCR-LA JUNTA IV, LLC

LAMAR & LA JUNTA, COLORADO

REVISED FEBRUARY 2018

This summary is submitted for the purpose of reflecting a proposed change in ownership structure whereby 25/7 Media, Inc. would purchase the stations owned by CCR in Lamar and La Junta, Colorado. This is not a rated market and therefore compliance with FCC 73.3555 multiple ownership requirements is determined by the contour overlap method. Please see **Figure 1** attached.

No facility technical changes are associated with this analysis.

The four stations are considered as three markets based on points of common overlap for all of the stations:

Market #1 KTHN(FM) and KBLJ(AM)

Market #2 KLMR(AM) and KBLJ(AM)

Market #3 KLMR-FM and KLMR(AM)

A multiple ownership analysis follows which considers the above described radio stations under proposed common ownership or control, which stations have overlapping principal community contours (5 mV/m for AM stations, 3.16 mV/m for FM stations) in accordance with *Section 73.3555* of the FCC Rules. For a market with 14 or fewer stations no person or entity, or entities under common control, may have a cognizable interest in more than 50% of the full power commercial and non-commercial radio stations.

Market #1 has two stations proposed for common ownership, KTHN(FM) and KBLJ(AM) and KRKV(FM), KPHT(FM), KVAY(FM) and KECC(FM) are owned by other entities so the 50% rule is complied with.

Market #2 has two stations proposed for common ownership, KLMR(AM) and KBLJ(AM), and KRKV(FM), KPHT(FM), KVAY(FM) and KCSE(FM) are not under proposed common ownership. This combination meets the 50% rule.


Market #3 has two stations, KLMR-FM and KLMR(AM) proposed for common ownership and there are three additional stations in the market that are not owned which are KCSE(FM), KVAY(FM) and KRKV(FM). This combination meets the 50% rule.
