Alex Media, Inc., as a winning bidder in Auction 91, now holds the right to file long form applications, but does not yet hold permits for new FM stations for the following market allotments:

- MM-FM777-C2 at Blanca, Colorado;
- MM-FM783-C3 at Cross City, Florida;
- MM-FM785-C2 at Islamorada, Florida;
- MM-FM793-C3 at McCall, Idaho;
- MM-FM796-A at Dulac, Louisiana; and
- MM-FM863-A at Wardensville, West Virginia.

Alexander Berger, the sole officer and director and 51% majority shareholder of Alex Media, Inc. does not hold any interest (cognizable or otherwise) in other broadcast facilities.¹

Wardensville, West Virginia is not within a BIA rated market. Because neither Alex Media, Inc. nor its sole majority shareholder holds a cognizable interest or local marketing agreement in any existing FM or AM station with any overlapping predicted contours with the proposed station, a grant of the instant application will result in Alex Media having a cognizable interest in a single FM station in the market.

Accordingly following a grant of the instant application, Alex Media and its sole majority shareholder will remain in full compliance with the multiple ownership restrictions contained within Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules.

¹ Alex Media's two non-cognizable minority shareholders, Evan Carb and Darryl Delawder hold interests through Miriam Media, Inc., in FM construction permits at Miles Texas (KMLS-FM) and Loleta, California (KMMI-FM), and a construction permit for a digital LPTV station K10QS-D at Incline Village, Nevada. Due to the presence of a 51% majority shareholder, such interests are not attributable to Alex Media, and in any event would not overlap the contour of the proposed station.
