

Description of Transaction

This application is for the FCC's consent to the involuntary change of the Trustee because of the death of James E. Rogers who was Trustee of the James E. Rogers Trust until his death; that trust owned 97.222% of the stock in Intermountain West Communications Company, a corporation ("IWCC"). IWCC's stock is held in two trusts, The James E. Rogers Trust and The Beverly Rogers Trust. The latter is controlled by Beverly Rogers, as sole trustee¹; it holds 2.777% of the stock in IWCC and that trust has not changed trustee.

The death of James E. Rogers on June 14, 2014, transferred control of his trust to his wife Beverly Rogers as the successor and controlling trustee of the James E. Rogers Trust. Two other persons were also appointed as co-trustees of the James E. Rogers Trust. They are Rory Reid and Tim Yock, both of whom are U.S. citizens with mailing addresses at 1500 Foremaster Lane, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101. The qualifications of Beverly Rogers were previously passed on by the FCC in BAPTTL-20050307ACC when Beartooth Communications acquired Station KBGF-LP in 2005.

The officers and directors of IWCC are: Beverly Rogers, director, chief executive officer and chairman of the board; Rory Reid, director; Tim Yock, director, treasurer and vice president; Lisa Howfield, president; Bob Stoldal, executive vice president; Fran Goldberg, secretary; Douglas Hill, vice president.

In addition to seeking a transfer of control of Intermountain West Communications Company due to the death of James E. Rogers, Beverly Rogers, as the successor and controlling trustee of Intermountain West Communications Company has made a business decision to convert Intermountain West Communications Company from a corporation to a limited liability company to be known as Intermountain West Communications, LLC. The ownership interest in the LLC will be the same as the previous ownership in the

corporation held by the James E. Rogers Trust and the Beverly Rogers Trust. Consequently, once the conversion of Intermountain West Communications from a corporation to a LLC is completed, the ownership interest in the James E. Rogers Trust as controlled by Beverly Rogers, will amount to 97.222% ownership interest of the LLC, as well as, her continuing 2.777% interest continuing will be held in the Beverly Rogers Trust as controlled by Beverly Rogers.

Intermountain West Communications in its corporate form, as well as, its LLC form will continue to manage as manager and parent of the following subsidiary licensee companies: Ruby Mountain Broadcasting, LLC (“Ruby Mountain”), the licensee of Station KENV-DT, Elko, Nevada; Sierra Communications, LLC (“Sierra”), the licensee of Station KRNV-DT², Reno, Nevada; Beartooth Communications Company (“Beartooth”), the licensee of Station KTVH-DT, Helena, Montana and Station KBGF-LP, Great Falls, Montana³; and Southern Nevada Communications Company, LLC (“Southern Nevada”) the licensee of Station KSNV-DT, Las Vegas, Nevada. The officers and directors of Intermountain West, Ruby Mountain, Beartooth and Sierra Nevada are Beverly Rogers, President; Tim Yock, treasurer and Fran Goldberg. The officers and directors of Southern Nevada are Lisa Howfield, president; Tim Yock, Treasurer and Fran Goldberg, secretary.
