The purpose of this exhibit is to demonstrate Cascade Community Radio, Inc's educational objective and that the proposed radio station will be used for the advancement of an educational program under 73.503(a) of the Rules. The rules describe that noncommercial licenses are not limited to classroom instruction, but may "transmit educational, cultural, and entertainment program to the general public," (Section 73.503(b)) in the advancement of a radio program. The following clearly demonstrates Cascade Community Radio, Inc's eligibility:

Cascade Community Radio is a nonprofit educational entity. Within its articles of incorporation filed with the Secretary of State of Oregon, it is stated that the corporation shall facilitate creative expression in radio broadcast and internet media by providing instruction to the public and access to resources, workshops and educational programs for the writing, preparation and creation of audio programming and media including live and recorded broadcast, webcasting and podcasting and other audio material. In addition, within its articles it describes that "the corporation is organized as a public benefit nonprofit corporation and shall be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes as those terms are defined in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code." The corporation's objective is well in-line with the qualification of being considered an educational nonprofit.

Cascades current educational program includes:


- Participating in working with the community to expand music education
- Working to extend media access for the Cascade Region
- Collaborating with Portland/NW media community (Musicians Union, community access television, internet radio, music promoters) with the intention of utilizing non-commercial media for artistic and informative educational purposes.

Cascade Community Radio, Inc. intends to utilize the proposed facility to extend its educational mission to the airwaves by carrying:

- Public affairs programming dealing with Northwest art, the environment, and public affairs.

- Music education: Public education of regional independent music artists, and historical genres of interest.
- Regional and independent news.

The proposed radio station intends on furthering the current mission described in our articles.
