AS THE LICENSEE PREVIOUSLY ADVISE THE FCC, W232AL LOST ITS TRANSMITTER SITE LEASE WITH CUMULUS BROADCASTING DUE TO THE TOWER SITE AGREEMENT BEING NULLIFIED BY A BANKRUPTCY JUDGE DURING CUMULUS BROADCASTING'S BANKRUPTCY PROCEEDING. THE FCC GRANTED THE STA TO ALLOW THE STATION TO RESUME OPERATIONS BEFORE ITS ONE YEAR OFF AIR DATE WHILE IT CONTINUED TO SEEK A PERMANENT SITE SOLUTION. ON APRIL 12, 2021, THE APPLICANT FILED A MINOR MODIFICATION TO RELOCATE THE W232AL FACILITY. THE APPLICATION WAS GRANTED ON JULY 7, 2021. THE APPLICANT IS REVIEWING ITS CONSTRUCTION OPTIONS WITH RESPECT TO IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MODIFICATION AUTHORIZATION. A GRANT OF THE STA EXTENSION WILL ALLOW THE APPLICANT TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC WHILE IT PLANS AND IMPLEMENTS ITS MODIFIED FACILITIES.

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## **UPDATED INFO FOR W232AL ENGINEERING STA EXTENSION (April 2022)**

The applicant has been in communication with the landlord's representative for the current W232AL CP site, but the rental process is long and difficult. The applicant is in continuing negotiations with the landlord of a superior site to which the applicant desires to move. The site is located in Fort Lee, New Jersey and would require the filing of an application for minor modification of its outstanding construction permit. The landlord of the building in Fort Lee, NJ, on which the tower is located is currently reviewing/considering a rooftop management agreement which would allow multiple antenna/communications tenants to locate atop the building. The applicant expects to get permission to relocate to the new site, after that management agreement is signed. At that time, applicant will file an application for minor modification of its CP.

A grant of this STA extension will allow the station to remain on the air providing service to the public.
