

Fair Distribution of Service

Educational Media Foundation (“EMF”) certifies that the proposed facility will provide a first NCE aural service to at least 10% of the persons residing in the proposed 60 dBu and that this population exceeds 2,000 persons.

In fact, as can be seen in Exhibits 10-A and 10-B, the proposed facility provides first service to 6,633 persons, which is 32.6% of the overall population within its 60 dBu service contour.

Currently KDRH has a first service population of 0 persons. The proposed facility has a first service population of 6,633 persons which is a first service gain of 6,633. The grant of the proposed major change would result in a great increase of first service population served which will make more efficient use of the NCE FM spectrum.

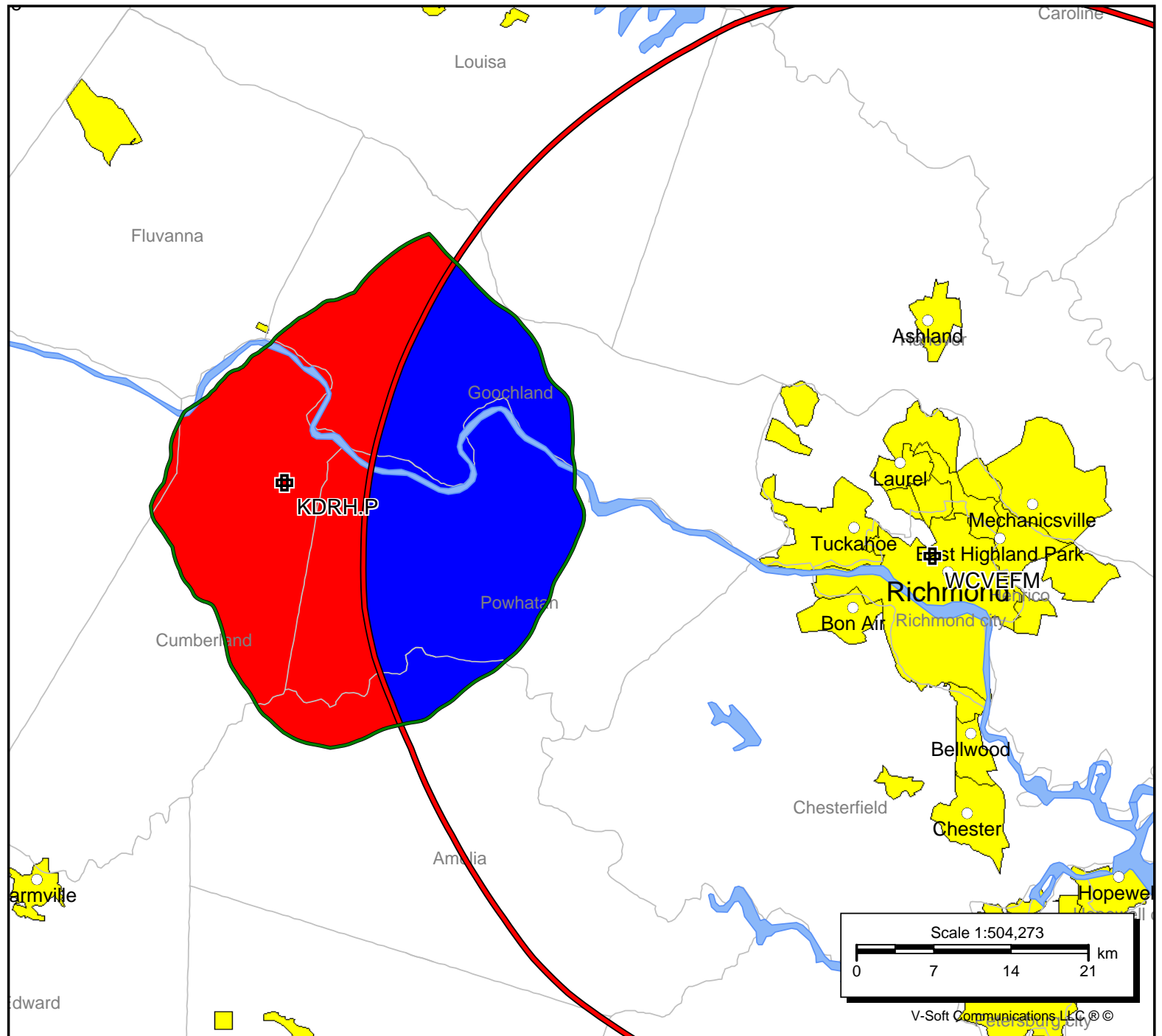
