I, ORALIA B. FRANCO, being first duly sworn, under oath and over the age of 18 years,
state:

- 1. I am a licensed and practicing attorney in the State of New Mexico.**

2. Robert Dane Coker and Judy Gail Coker filed for bankruptcy protection in the United States Bankruptcy Court for New Mexico in Case Number 7 98-10965 RR. I was appointed and served as the 341 Trustee in the case.

3. Robert Dane Coker and Judy Gail Coker, d.b.a. Coker Broadcasting Co., d.b.a. Radio Station KKEK-AM, were the holders and owners of Federal Communications Commission license Radio Station KWEW-AM (now KKEK-AM), Hobbs, New Mexico, 1480 KC, 5000 watts daytime, 1000 watts nighttime.

4. Robert Dane Coker and Judy Gail Coker executed to KWEW, Inc., promissory notes, a security interest for its promissory notes, as evidenced by the Financing Statement recorded in Book 18, Page 548, the Security Agreement recorded in Book 18, Page 550, and the Continuation Statement recorded in Book 26, Page 224, of the records of Lea County, New Mexico.

5. As the 341 Trustee, I abandoned the property, and the United States Bankruptcy Court for New Mexico entered its order for relief from stay with respect to the property which is described in the promissory notes and security agreements, including Federal Communications Commission license Radio Station KKEI-AM, so that KWEE, Inc. could recover title to the property.

6. The Debtors were discharged.
