Dear Applicant:

This refers to the above-captioned minor change application for K228FC.

An engineering study reveals the application is in violation of the interference protection requirements of 47 C.F.R. Section 74.1204. Specifically, the proposed 40 dBu interfering contour overlaps the 60 dBu protected contour of the facilities of a co-channel LPFM construction permit for a new station in Wimberley, Texas (BNPL-20131114AVE). The application does not recognize this defect. Accordingly, we dismiss the application as unacceptable for filing.

In light of the above, application BMPFT-20160129AYC is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.


