

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions

The K220HC Construction Permit (File Number BPFT-20180327AAG) contains three Special Operating Conditions:

- 1. K220HC, specified in BPFT-20180327AAG, cannot file a license application to cover BPFT-20180327AAG or commence operation until K220FR, specified in BPFT-20180327AAF, commences operation and files a license application to cover BPFT-20180327AAF*
- 2. The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.*
- 3. Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.*

Educational Media Foundation (“EMF”) complies with, or agrees to, the conditions as follows:

1. K220FR commenced operation on January 23, 2019. A Form 350 License application for K220FR was filed on January 23, 2019 with file confirmation number 20190123AAG.
2. Educational Media Foundation, in coordination with other users of the site, agrees to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
3. Form 350 is being filed prior to commencing program test operations.
