

Local Radio Ownership Showing

This application seeks Commission consent to the assignment of the license of Station WTHK(FM), Burlington, New Jersey, from Nassau Broadcasting II, L.L.C. to Greater Philadelphia Radio, Inc. (“Greater Philadelphia”). Greater Philadelphia is an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of Greater Media, Inc. (“Greater Media”).

For purposes of the local radio ownership rule, WTHK(FM) is deemed to be a part of the Trenton, New Jersey Arbitron Metro. WTHK(FM) is licensed to Burlington, New Jersey, Burlington County, which in turn is located in the Trenton, New Jersey Metro, as defined by Arbitron. The attached exhibit was compiled on July 31, 2006 using BIA Research, Inc.’s *Media Access Pro* database. The exhibit lists all radio stations, including WTHK(FM), that are licensed to communities within the counties comprising the Trenton, New Jersey Metro or that Arbitron designates as “home” to that Metro. As demonstrated in the exhibit, there are 14 stations in the Trenton, New Jersey Metro, as so defined. Under the local radio ownership rule, a person or single entity (or entities under common control) in a radio market with 14 or fewer full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations may have a cognizable interest in up to 5 commercial radio stations (not more than 3 commercial stations in the same service (AM or FM)), except that a party may not have a cognizable interest in more than 50% of the total number of full-power commercial and noncommercial stations in such market. As shown in the exhibit, GMI presently does not control any radio stations in the Trenton, New Jersey Metro. Upon the consummation of this transaction, GMI will control one FM station (WTKH(FM)), which ownership fully complies with local radio ownership rule.
