

PLUS SEVEN INTERFERENCE WAIVER EXHIBIT

The parameters stated in this minor modification application to channel 50 is predicted to cause +7 interference to full power station Channel 57, KJLA serving Ventura, CA. Permittee respectfully request a waiver of the predicted interference for the reasons set forth below.

KTRO-LP is applying for an ERP of 26 kW while KJLA is authorized to serve its target service area of Ventura, CA with an ERP of 5000 kW. This result in a D/U ratio of -22.84dB , which is lower than the -30 dB outlined in OET Bulletin No. 69. The -22.84dB is the worst case and therefore in all KJLA's service area, the dBu requirements is met at all times avoiding the +7 interference. In addition, KTRO-LP transmitter is located 78.4 km away from KJLA's transmitter site and KTRO-LP serves Lancaster, CA, a completely different community from that served by KJLA. Therefore it is zero likely that two receivers in adjacent apartments would be watching the two stations.
