

SECTION 307(b) STATEMENT

Tichenor License Corporation seeks to relocate its KAMA-FM transmitter site and change its community of license from Missouri City, TX to Deer Park, TX. As detailed further in the attached engineering exhibit, this relocation and change in community of license will result in a preferential arrangements of allotments and complies with the Commission's policies governing community of license changes.

Section 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, states that the Commission must distribute broadcast licenses to states and communities so "as to provide a fair, efficient, and equitable distribution of radio service." 47 U.S.C. 307. Pursuant to the rules promulgated as a result of Section 307(b), the Commission's allotment priorities are as follows: (1) first full-time aural reception service; (2) second full-time aural reception service; (3) first local aural transmission service; and (4) other public interest factors. Co-equal weight is given to priorities (2) and (3). Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC Rcd 2d 88 (1982) In this situation, moving KAMA-FM to Deer Park, TX will result in the addition of a first local aural transmission service to Deer Park, TX, as there are presently no other radio stations licensed to that community. Similarly, Missouri City, TX will continue to be served by ~~(1) KLTN (FM), which is filing an application concurrently pursuant to 73,3517 to change its community of license from Houston, TX to Missouri City, TX; and (2) upon the filing of a license to cover application, KBRZ(AM), which recently filed a license to cover application to receive a construction permit (FCC File No. BP 20070125ADS) to change its community of license to Missouri City, TX.~~ Furthermore, Missouri City, TX will continue to receive ample service from 1 station, as demonstrated in the attached Engineering Statement (Exhibit 32A).

Deer Park, TX is an established community with the social, economic, and cultural characteristics that warrant first local aural transmission services. Deer Park, located in Harris County, is an incorporated community of 28,520 people. Incorporated in 1892, the community has an independent school district, local government, local business, churches and community identity, as detailed in the attached Exhibit 32a. Thus, the addition of KAMA-FM to this community is consistent with the Commission's Rules and would serve the public interest.

As stated in the instructions to the FCC Form 301, the following information is provided below and in the attached Engineering Exhibit:

- 1) If new technical facilities are proposed, the area and population within the proposed 60 dBU contour of the station: The new proposed contours for KAMA-FM at Deer Park will be: 4,018,885 people; 7,489.5 Sq. Km.
- 2) The number of stations presenter licensed to the proposed new community of license: 0. This will be the community's first local aural transmission service.

3) The number of stations providing protected service to the proposed community of license: More than 20. See attached Engineering Statement Exhibit 32a.

4) The population, according to the latest Census Date, of the proposed community of license: The population of the community of Deer Park is 28,520 persons according to the 2000 U. S. Census data.

Given the overall preferential arrangement proposed by this ~~and the coordinated contingent application to relocate KLTN (FM), Facility ID #65310 to Missouri City, TX,~~ the Commission should approve the relocation of KAMA-FM requested herein, ~~contingent upon the relocation application of commonly owned and controlled KLTN or the filing of a license application covering FCC File No. BP 20070125ADS.~~

Proposed Technical Facilities

The proposed new technical facilities for KAMA-FM, are located at an existing tower at 8.8 KW and 298m HAAT. This facility meets 73.215 spacing requirements. Below is a table of the gain in population and area in this proposed modification.



The population of Deer Park, Texas, according to the 2000 Census was 28,520.


Replacement of Service at Missouri City, Texas

The contingent application from Univision Radio Houston License Corporation proposes to replace the first service at Missouri City, Texas. Additionally, there is a construction permit outstanding from Alclaya Christian Broadcasting, Inc., for Radio station KBRZ (AM), Facility ID 12156, which asked for a has recently filed a license to cover application to change its change in-city of license to provide local aural service to Missouri City, Texas. This was mistakenly referred to as a first local service in the application. When this facility is licensed, it will provide an additional service to the KLTN (FM) first service, presently provided by KPTY, so that Missouri City will have a total two local services for its population of 52,913. PROTECTED AM CONTOURS (2 MV/M) SERVING DEER PARK, TEXAS


