

**Compliance with Special Operating Conditions**

The Construction Permit contains several Special Operating Conditions, summarized as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the grant of this construction permit or the expiration date specified herein, KYKA's license will automatically expire as a matter of law on October 11, 2013 if the station has not resumed broadcasting before that time.
2. Waiver of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1125 is granted to allow operation of the facility authorized by this construction permit as a satellite operation of station KLVR-FM.
3. Permittee has specified use of an eight bay, circularly polarized, nondirectional FM transmit antenna with 0.5 wavelength bay spacing to demonstrate compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines. If any other type of size of antenna is to be used with the facilities authorized herein, the automatic program test provisions of section 73.1620 will not apply, and a formal request for program test authority, including a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines, must be filed in conjunction with FCC Form 302-FM before program tests will be authorized.
4. Upon receipt of notification from the Commission that harmful interference to the FAA is being caused by the operation of KYKA's transmitter, the permittee/licensee shall either immediately reduce the power to the point of no interference, cease operation, or take such immediate corrective action as is necessary to eliminate the harmful interference. This condition expires after one year of interference-free operation.
5. The permittee/licensee, in coordination with other users of the site, must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), complies with, or agrees to, these conditions, as follows:

1. KYKA has resumed operation prior to October 11, 2013. Therefore, this condition is not applicable.
2. EMF reiterates the commitments outlined in its request for waiver of section 73.1125. See also Exhibit 6.
3. EMF has used the specified antenna. No further action is required.
4. EMF agrees, upon receipt of notification from the Commission that harmful interference to the FAA is being caused by the operation of KYKA's transmitter, to either immediately reduce the power to the point of no interference, cease operation, or take such immediate corrective action as is necessary to eliminate the harmful interference.
5. EMF agrees, in coordination with other users of the site, to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

Therefore, all Special Operating Conditions of the KYKA Construction Permit (FCC File Number BMPED-20130627ABS) have been met.
