Dear Applicant:

On October 20, 2009, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter outlining the following issues:

Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. W32DF, Hempstead, NY. – BLTTL-20090522AEX

We are not accepting or using the Full Service Mask in our interference analysis until it becomes part of our technical rules.

You were given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified interference problem within (30) days from the date of that letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

In addition the licensee was given an extension of time to resolve the above referenced interference problem.

Our records indicate that an amendment was filed on October 26, 2009. Our preliminary engineering review, with the engineering amendment considered, reveals that your proposed facility is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. W32DF, Hempstead, NY. – BLTTL-20090522AEX at 71.1%

On November 10, 2009, a second amendment was filed and our engineering review taking in account the specifications of the amendment revealed the same results as indicated above, your facility is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. W32DF, Hempstead, NY. – BLTTL-20090522AEX at 71.1%

As we were in the process of reviewing the exhibit attachments i.e. interference studies, the licensee filed a third amendment on December 8, 2009, in which the exhibit and attachments were deleted whereas, removing them from further consideration.

On December 10, 2009, we ran another engineering analysis taking into account the engineering specifications of the December 8, 2009, amendment and our review revealed that your proposed facility is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. W32DF, Hempstead, NY. – BLTTL-20090522AEX at 4.7%

Due to the results of the third amendment, the above referenced application is considered incomplete and IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
